Comments: There are 70 faculty ( $68 \%$ of Teacher Education faculty) currently engaged in the work of TPI. Ten faculty are from departments outside of the Teacher Education Unit, such as Biology, Community Psychology, Counseling and Family Therapy. These participants are engaged in making recommendations for changes to Teacher Education, or working to implement recommendations in their own programs along with P -12 partners and other faculty and staff outside of their program.

All of the lead staff in School of Education, excluding office staff, are involved in TPI work. We also have engaged Career Services, Admissions, Multicultural Services, and Information Services.
