

## Minnesota Indian Teacher Training Program: St. Cloud State University Application

Scholarship Application

The Minnesota Indian Teacher Training Program provides scholarships, mentoring and support for American Indian students starting, continuing or completing a teacher preparation program or another eligible program focusing on any area of Pre-K-12 employment.

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Priority is given to American Indian students who are tribally enrolled and then to first and second generation descendants.
- 2. St. Cloud State University (undergraduate or graduate) admissions with MITTP eligible major.
- 3. MITTP Scholarship application available at www.stcloudstate.edu/aic
- 4. Free Application for Federal Student Aid/FAFSA with financial need that remains unmet by government guidelines and determined by SCSU Financial Aid Office.
- 5. By applying for MITTP you are agreeing to participate in required MITTP support activities at St. Cloud State University, which includes a mentoring seminar with SCSU faculty, Darlene St. Clair.
- 6. In order to participate in the MITTP program, applicants must meet the requirements of their academic program, and your FASFA must be completed.
