



Minnesota Indian Teacher Training Program: St. Cloud State University Application

Scholarship Application

The Minnesota Indian Teacher Training Program provides scholarships, mentoring and support for American Indian students starting, continuing or completing a teacher preparation program or another eligible program focusing on any area of Pre-K-12 employment.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Priority is given to American Indian students who are tribally enrolled and then to first and second generation descendants.
2. St. Cloud State University (undergraduate or graduate) admissions with MITTP eligible major.
3. MITTP Scholarship application available at www.stcloudstate.edu/aic
4. Free Application for Federal Student Aid/FAFSA with financial need that remains unmet by government guidelines and determined by SCSU Financial Aid Office.
5. By applying for MITTP you are agreeing to participate in required MITTP support activities at St. Cloud State University, which includes a mentoring seminar with SCSU faculty, Darlene St. Clair.
6. In order to participate in the MITTP program, applicants must meet the requirements of their academic program, and your FASFA must be completed.
