



## When do we report enrollment data?

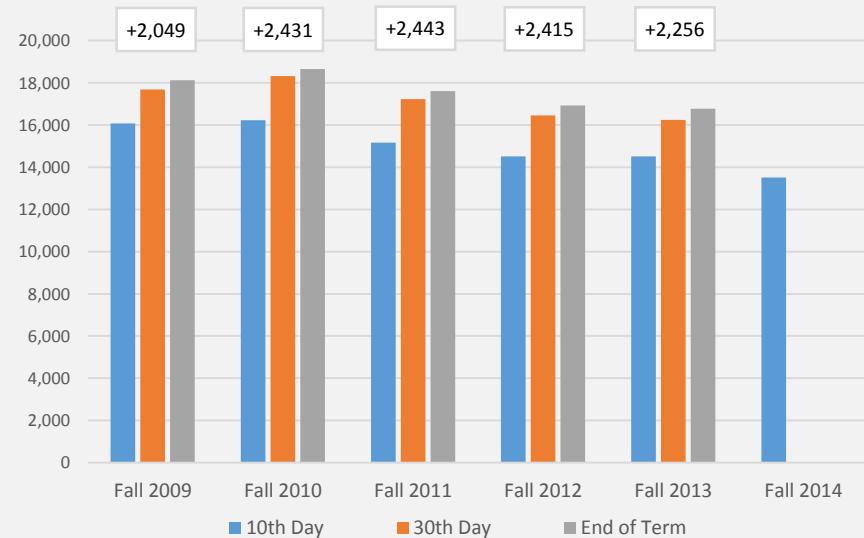
“Student headcount” is the number of students enrolled for one or more credits and varies day to day as students register or are dropped from enrollment.

We record enrollment at three different points during fall and spring semesters:

- **10<sup>th</sup> Day** of classes (Sept. 8) gives an early indication of how enrollment is progressing.
- **30<sup>th</sup> Day** of classes (Oct. 6) is used by MnSCU and St. Cloud State for official reporting.
- **End of Term** is 45 days after the semester ends (Feb. 2).

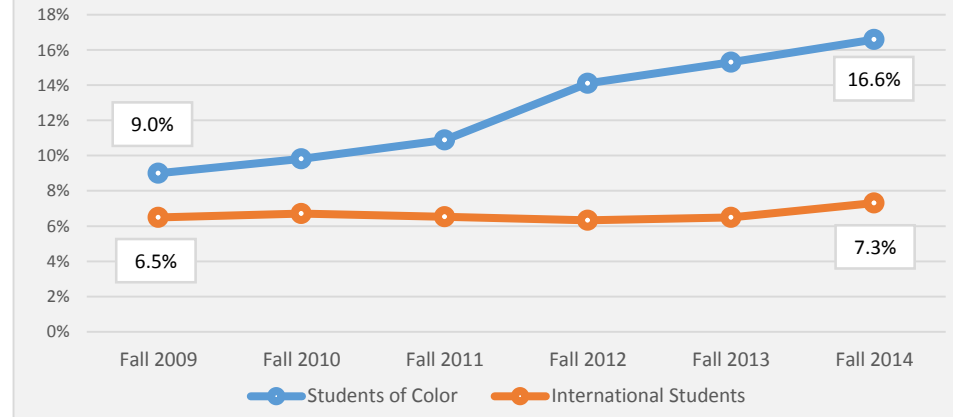
Changing registration timelines for concurrent enrollment and graduate enrollment causes variation in historical patterns.

## How much does enrollment change from the 10<sup>th</sup> Day to the End of Term?



Although 10<sup>th</sup> day total enrollment has dropped since Fall 2009, the headcount for Students of Color and International Students combined has increased by 722. These students now constitute 16.6% (Students of Color) and 7.3% (International Students) of our total enrollment.
