SCSU CULTURAL NIGHTS- COVID-19

While Cultural Nights will need to look a little different from previous years, here are 3 options for face-to-face Cultural Nights in 2020-2021:

Option A: Ritsche Auditorium Performance with Grab-and-Go Food (At end of event)

Max Audience Size = 243* (Physically-distanced Auditorium Seating)

Option B: Ballroom Performance with Take-Home or Grab-and-Go Food

Max Audience Size = 150* (Physically-distanced Row Seating)

Option C: Ballroom Performance with Served Buffet

Max Audience Size = 100* (Physically-distanced Classroom Seating- 1 person per 6-ft table)


* These events could be offered as "Hybrid" with additional "audience" members watching via Zoom.

THINGS TO PLAN FOR:

- To manage crowd/attendees both BEFORE and AFTER show, you will want to have **at least 10 volunteers** available to direct traffic, take tickets, etc.
- If food is being sent home with attendees, rather than being eaten at the event, the **food should be items that do not need to be kept hot or cold**. If you want to serve food that needs to stay at a certain
 temp, plan for the Served Buffet option (Option C). (Creative twist- send home recipe cards with
 attendees, so they can make the dish at home if it can't easily be served at event!)
- Plan for **performers to keep 6-feet of distance** from one another on stage. (Depending on how much space each performer needs to move around, we could get 4-6 dancers on stage at once).
- Meet with Atwood staff (Jayne Balicky) AT LEAST 30 days prior to event to discuss event and safety requirements. (<u>Jayne.balicky@stcloudstate.edu</u> | 320-308-2075 | AMC 134)

Kimberly A. Ritsche Auditorium Seating Diagram




