Question 1: How well did the project align with the 'Elements of Service Learning'?

#### **Elements of Service Learning**

- Students provide some meaningful service (work)
- ▶ The service provided meets a need or goal
- The need or goal is defined by a community (or some of its members)

#### **Elements of Service Learning**

- The service provided by students flows from and into course objectives
- The service is integrated into the course by means of assignments that require some form of reflection on the service in light of the course objectives
- ▶ The assignment is assessed and evaluated accordingly

#### Feedback

Question 1: How well did the project align with the 'Elements of Service Learning'?

Average Ranking

3.74

- Ranking
  - 0 = no alignment
  - 1 = slight alignment
  - 2 = moderate alignment
  - ▶ 3 = good alignment
  - 4 = excellent alignment

#### Feedback

Question 2: How well did the project align with the course objectives?

- Ranking

  - 1 = slight alignment
- Average Ranking 3.45
  - 2 = moderate alignment ▶ 3 = good alignment
  - ▶ 4 = excellent alignment

#### Feedback

- Question 3: How would you rank your overall experience?
- Ranking

  - Average Ranking 2.73

#### Feedback

- Overall, students appreciate the project
- Some gain understand of their impact whether it be significant or slight (Meals of Wheels)

#### Feedback

- Common complaints
  - ▶ This isn't something that will help me in the long run
  - I'd rather just write a pape
  - One of my group mates didn't do any of the work
  - Mandatory volunteering
