BE ADVISED...

- 1. All SCSU students must complete a minimum of 120 to graduate.
- 2. All SCSU students must have at least 45 credits of 300/400 level courses to graduate.
- All SCSU students complete a minimum of 40 credits of Liberal Education courses AND meet the requirements of all 10 goal areas, including RIGR and Diversity.
- 4. Students with the Political Science major are required to complete a minor, second major, or one year of a foreign language.
- 5. POL 101 and 111 may be taken in any order. POL 101, 111, and 251 must be completed before applying for the major.
- 6. POL 201 and 251 should be taken as soon as possible in the second year of study.
- 7. Study abroad is highly recommended and the advisor or program director can be consulted for up to 12 credits of elective substitutions for a study abroad experience.
- 8. Students must earn a C- or better in POL courses.
