1. A double major in Art and Psychology is recommended for students who wish pursue graduate degrees required for careers in art therapy. The double major is not a formal program in pre-art therapy. This degree map will help students earn two majors in the fewest credits possible.
2. Recommended route; actual order of courses may vary. Because of foundations requirements and prerequisites, students should begin working on an art major during their first semester and their psychology major during their first or second semester if they wish to graduate in four years.
3. Priority Registration and Advising Day. **Art majors must participate in the art department's priority registration and advising day each semester if they expect to take any art courses the following semester.** Because of high student demand and limited course availability, each semester the art department holds a priority registration and advising day for intended and admitted art majors. Students who are undecided, not officially recognized as intended, or not officially admitted to an art major when they are eligible may take art courses only on a space-available basis after priority registration is completed.
4. Students *must* declare that they are intended art majors as soon as they are admitted to SCSU if they want to be eligible to register for art courses. New-entering first-year students should attend the university's first orientation sessions if they want to insure enrollment into art courses. Students should declare their intended psychology major as soon as possible
5. Students are eligible for admission to art major after completing foundations courses (Art 101-105) with a 2.5 grade point average **and** passing the departmental portfolio review. Students should declare their psychology major after taking 11 credits of psychology and having at least a 2.50 GPA (overall).
6. Some graduate programs in art therapy require a course in art education, which could be substituted for Art 201.

To graduate with a Bachelor's degree, students must earn a minimum of 120 credits

51 credits = BA Art Major (includes 6 liberal education credits)

41 credits = BA Psychology Major (includes 6 liberal education credits)

28 credits = Liberal Education; 40 required. Double BA Art and Psychology majors earn 12 credits in goals 5, 6, and 8.

Note: Included in all of the above must be 40 or more credits of upper-level courses (300-400).
