This degree has more credits required than most others. You may find it helpful to take a few summer courses in order to help reduce your credit load during the fall or spring semesters. There are additional, non-credit bearing requirements for graduation, including CPR training, licensure exams, and state-administered tests. Your advisor will provide specific details on these requirements.

Programs at St. Cloud State University (SCSU) that lead to a professional licensure or certification are intended to prepare a student for potential licensure or certification in Minnesota (MN). While SCSU programs meet the relevant academic requirements set by the licensure or certification board/agency in MN, they may or may not meet the educational requirements for a licensure or certification in another state. If you are planning to seek professional licensure or certification outside MN, it is important for you to know the specific requirements of the state in which you intend to apply for licensure or certification.
