Bachelor of Science – Community Psychology and/or Chemical Dependency

Transfer Process

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Community Psychology or Chemical Dependency should follow the admission procedures located on the following website in order to be admitted to St. Cloud State University: <u>www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer</u>. Being admitted to SCSU is a separate process than that of being admitted into a major program. A student must first be accepted to SCSU, and then may apply to a major once certain requirements have been met.

Requirements for Admission to the Community Psychology major

• GPA of 2.0 or higher and submission of major application

- Requirements for Admission to the Chemical Dependency major
 - GPA of 2.0 or higher and submission of formal application and successful completion of interview

The following major courses transfer from Century College to SCSU

Century College Course		SCSU Course
PSYC 1041 – Development Psych: Lifespan	\rightarrow	PSY 240 <u>or</u> CEEP 262
PSYC 1020 – General Psychology	\rightarrow	PSY 115
Math 1025 – Stats	\rightarrow	Stat 219

- It is recommended that students take the lower-division major courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or Associate in Arts (AA) degree if possible.
- If a student completes a goal area within the MnTC, the same goal area will be completed at St. Cloud State University once transferred.

Additional Requirements to Consider when Degree Planning

- Completion of 10 goal areas (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at St. Cloud State)
- 45 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) required to graduate from SCSU
- Additional major requirements: *Community Psychology Major* (44 Credits)
 - o CPSY 101, 102, 323, 324, 325, 330, 384, 433, 327 or 434, 326 or 444 or 445, CEEP 419, 476
 - o STAT 219
 - o Electives with consent of CPSY advisor
- Additional major requirements: *Chemical Dependency Major* (81 credits)
 - o Community Psychology Courses: CPSY 101, 102, 323, 324, 325, 327, 330, 384, 433, CEEP 419, 476
 - o Chemical Dependency Courses: CPSY 402, 428, 437, 438, 439, 445, 446, 484
 - o STAT 219
