MATH 1090 – Statway Statistics 2 OR	$\rightarrow$	STAT 193 *ASHA Statistics Standard
MATH 1080 – Intro to Stats		

Note: Either Chemistry or Physics is preferred to meet ASHA Physical Sciences standard, but not required. ASHA will also consider Astronomy or Earth and Atmospheric Science as a "Physical Science".

### Notes:

- *Note:* To meet ASHA (American Speech-Language-Hearing Association) Certification Standards, students must take one course in each of these four areas: <u>Biological Sciences, Physical Sciences, Social/Behavioral Sciences, and Statistics.</u> Suggestions are provided in the table above.
- The Communication Sciences and Disorders B.S. degree requires electives or the completion of a minor in another department.
- It is recommended that students take the lower-division major courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or Associate in Arts (AA) degree if possible.
- If a student completes a goal area within the MnTC, the same goal area will be completed at St. Cloud State University once transferred.
- Completion of 10 goal areas (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at St. Cloud State University) is required to earn a degree from SCSU.
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) are required to graduate from SCSU
