Bachelor of Science - Social Work Transfer Guide

Transfer Process

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Social Work should follow the admission procedures located on the following website in order to be admitted to St. Cloud State University: www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer. Being admitted to SCSU is a separate process than that of being admitted into a major program. A student may apply to the social work major after all core courses have been completed.

The following Social Work Core courses transfer from St. Cloud Technical & Community College to SCSU

MATH 1351 – Intro to Statistics	\rightarrow	STAT 193
DVRS 1304 – Diversity & Social Justice	\rightarrow	HURL 201

The following Social Work Core courses need to be taken at SCSU: SW 195, SW 216, HURL 206

Notes:

- Students must complete all Social Work Core (Pre-Social Work) classes to be eligible to begin in the major. These classes are: BIOL 103, HURL 201, HURL 206, PSY 240/CEEP 262, STAT 193, SW 195, SW 216, SOC 160.
- Additional major requirements: SW 216, 330, 340, 345, 350, 360, 410, 411, 412, 443, 444, 445.
 - The major requirements are organized sequentially into 4 total semesters (2 years) and <u>cannot</u> be taken in conjunction with any core classes.
 - Typically the major courses are offered in the following format:
 - 1st semester: M/W, 2nd and 3rd semester: T/Th, 4th semester: Fridays
- Completion of 10 goal areas (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at SCSU).
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) required to graduate from SCSU.
