Transfer Guide - Art

Transfer Process

All transfer students seeking a major in **Art** should follow the admission procedures located at www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer to be admitted to St. Cloud State. Students are automatically admitted into a program and would need to meet minimum program requirements to graduate with that degree program. The Art Department at St. Cloud State offers the following programs: **Bachelor of Arts in Art; Bachelor of Fine Arts in 2D Media, 3D Media, Graphic Design or Integrated Media and Bachelor of Science in Art Education**. Art majors are encouraged to apply to St. Cloud State prior to October 1st/March 1st; students recommended to meet with Art Department chairperson by October 22nd/March 22nd.

In order to progress in the major, Art majors must meet the following unless otherwise approved by the department chair:

- Bachelor of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Arts in Art degrees:
 - Completion of the 15-credit first-year foundation sequence: ART 101, ART 102, ART 103, ART 104, ART 105 with a 2.5 GPA or higher
 - Completion of Art Department portfolio review
- Bachelor of Science in Art Education
 - Completion of the 15-credit first-year foundation sequence: ART 101, ART 102, ART 103, ART 104, ART 105 with a 2.5 GPA or higher; cumulative GPA 2.75 or higher
 - ENGL 191 and CMST 192 (or transfer course equivalents) must be completed with a C or higher
 - Completion of Art Department portfolio review

The following courses are *suggested* for particular MnTC Goals:

NHCC Course
Goal 1: ENGL 1201 and 1202; COMM 1610 (also falls in Goal 9)
Goal 3 and Goal 10: ANTH 1020, GEOG 1010 or GEOL 1850
Goal 5 and Goal 7: PSYC 1170, PSYC 2340, SOC 1110, SOC 2210, HIST 1200, HIST 1210, or HIST 1270

- It is recommended that students take these courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC).
- If a student completes a Goal within the MnTC, the same Goal will be completed at St. Cloud State once transferred.

The following courses are *recommended* for students interested in Art Education as part of Teacher Licensure:

NHCC Course	SCSU Course
PSYC 1210 Child Development <u>and</u> PSYC 1220 Adult Development <u>OR</u> PSYC 1250 Life Span Developmental Psychology	CPSY 262 Human Growth and Development or PSY 240 Lifespan Developmental Psychology

Additional Requirements to Consider when Degree Planning:

- Completion of 10 Goals (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at St. Cloud State)
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) are required to graduate
- Art programs require a cumulative GPA of 2.5 to graduate
