Transfer Guide - Bachelor of Arts in Theatre

Transfer Process

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Arts in Theatre should follow the admission procedures located at www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer to be admitted to St. Cloud State. A student must first be accepted to St. Cloud State, and then may apply to the major after meeting the major's admission requirements.

- If a student completes a Goal within the MnTC, the same Goal will be completed at St. Cloud State once transferred.

Additional Requirements to Consider when Degree Planning:

- Completion of 10 Goals (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at St. Cloud State)
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) required to graduate
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher to graduate
