Parliamentary Debate: NPDA rules will govern debate with the following exceptions: in-room topic announcement; no coaching/team prep during the 15 minute preparation time; no flex-time; dictionary use only during prep time; and no internet access during prep or rounds. Some rounds may be judged by a lay judge. SCSU students will also participate in the tournament.

Judging

One judge will cover two debate teams. All judges are expected to be available and considered "clean" for elimination rounds.

Awards

The top five speakers and out-round participants will be recognized.

Fees

Fees will be assessed at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, February 1, 2022.
