## Transfer Guide – BS Social Studies Education

### Transfer Process

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Science in Social Studies Education should follow the admission procedures located at [www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer](http://www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer) to be admitted to St. Cloud State University (SCSU).

### Requirements for Admission to the Social Studies Education Major:

- Overall GPA of 2.5 or higher

### Admission to Teacher Education:

Professional Education Sequence for Pre K-12 & 5-12 Licensure (39 credits): [ED 300](#), [CPSY 262](#) or [PSY 240](#), [CPSY 361](#), [IM 422](#), [HURL 497](#), [ENGL 460](#) or [ED 460](#), [SPED 203](#), [ED 421](#), [ED 431](#), and [ED 441](#) or [SSE 441](#) (co-requisites); [ED 451](#); [ED 466](#) or [ED 467](#).

*Admission to Teacher Education is required for placement in student teaching.*

- Social Studies Education majors must complete the Liberal Education Program, Social Studies Teaching courses for licensure, and the Professional Education component. Many courses required in this major also meet requirements within the Liberal Education Program.
- All courses in the Social Studies Teaching Sequence must receive a grade of “C” or higher to count toward major course completion.
- [HIST 385](#), [HIST 470](#), [SSE 411](#), and [SSE 421](#) must be completed 2-3 semesters before student teaching (1-2 Semesters before ED Block).
- [SSE 453](#) must be completed the semester prior to student teaching with a grade of C or higher. Pre- or co-requisites: [ED 421](#), [ED 431](#), [ED 451](#), [SSE 441](#).
- 2.75 overall GPA is required to enroll in [ED 466](#) and [ED 467](#) [Student Teaching].

### The following courses *are suggested* for particular MnTC Goals:

ENGL 1302: Analytical Writing (Goal 1W) <u>OR</u> ENGL 2302: Argument & Research (Goal 1W) <u>OR</u> ENGL 2304 Advanced Argument & Research Writing (Goal 1W)	ENGL 191: Intro to Rhetorical & Analytical Writing
CMST 1320: Intro to Communication Studies (Goal 1S)	CMST 192: Intro to Communication Studies

It is recommended that students take these courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or Associate of Arts (AA) degree.

If a student completes a Goal within the MnTC, the same Goal will be completed at SCSU once transferred.

**Additional Requirements to Consider when Degree Planning:**

- Completion of 10 Goals (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at SCSU)
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) and a 2.0 GPA are required to graduate from SCSU
- Completion of three Diversity courses. (May be adjusted depending on the amount of transfer credits). One Diversity course must be an approved Racial Issues Graduation Requirement (RIGR) course (see Goal 7 for RIGR courses).
- Complete Residency Requirement: 30 credits must be earned at SCSU
- Earn a minimum of 120 credits to graduate with a bachelor's degree
