### Requirements to become a Husky STEM Teacher Scholar:

1. Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
2. Major in Mathematics, Chemistry, or Physics and obtain teacher licensing upon completion. (Mathematics Teaching, Chemistry Education and Physics Education majors to qualify.)
3. Commit to teaching in a high needs district for two years within eight years of graduation.
4. Be employed at SCSU as a Learning Assistant for at least two semesters. This is a paid position.
5. Work with an assigned teacher mentor in the St. Cloud School district in your field for field experiences and action research projects.
6. Note: There is no minimum GPA requirement for the scholarship other than being in good standing within your program and have the ability to qualify for licensure in the state of MN.
