HOW TO APPLY TO ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY

Graduate admission requirements

An applicant must meet ONE of the following Grade Point Average (GPA) standards to be eligible for academic admission consideration to the School of Graduate Studies:

1. Possess at least an overall 2.75 GPA (4.0 scale) in your previous undergraduate work.
2. Possess at least an overall 2.75 GPA (4.0 scale) in the last half of your undergraduate work.

An applicant with graduate coursework must meet one of the above requirements, plus possess at least an overall 3.00 GPA (4.0 scale) in his/her graduate course work.

QUALITY OF LIFE

St. Cloud has grown from its early days of granite quarries and river trade to a population of roughly 100,000 in the city and its outlying areas.

The city lies along the scenic Mississippi River and offers an abundance of year-round natural beauty and cultural opportunity. Theaters, restaurants, parks and outdoor recreational activities are all within walking distance of campus.

On campus, diverse and affordable entertainment options are available to students and the community. Concert, theater, recreational and gallery facilities host musicians, speakers, artists, and actors of both national and local renown. Award-winning and student-centered programming complements the cultural life of the city and the graduate-student experience.

Sports facilities include a football/soccer stadium (domed and heated in the winter), two indoor Olympic-sized hockey rinks, and a 200-meter indoor track, basketball and racquetball courts, weight rooms and a fitness center.

In addition to charm and vitality, this college town offers affordable housing. Students can expect to pay anywhere from \$300 to \$650 per month for one of the more than 10,000 apartments available within 10 miles from campus.

If you need adventure, a short, one-hour drive southeast, Minneapolis and St. Paul offer nationally recognized art, music, entertainment and restaurants.
