Dear CMHC Students,

While you are ready to take Practicum classes, you will require to obtain a secure flash drive for video recording. Such flash drive is necessary for compliance with professional ethical codes and will protect the confidentiality of volunteers who serve in your sessions.

Here is the information on the secure flash drive you can purchase for practicum use. The Corsair 16 GB 2.0 is used in previous cohorts, and it had worked well for students in previous practicum classes. We recommend you to purchase one with secure codes physically located on the flash drive. The software lock tends to be unreliable. A secure flash drive with lock buttons or luck combination codes on it will be a better choice for practicum use.

You will need to have it by the second or third week when we start recording. And, our technical consultant suggests you re-format this drive regularly (once you are done with reviewing the videos) to maintain its function with the recording devices in our lab.
