### COURSE SCHEDULE

The Doctorate in Educational Administration and Leadership is 72 credits in length. A maximum of 27 credits can be applied towards doctoral program electives upon approval. A mixture of master's (12 credits max.) and post-master's (licensure) (27 credits max.) can be used for the 27 credit maximum.
