## Accelerate yourself to becoming a licensed Minnesota teacher!

The Accelerated Post Baccalaureate Program (post-bacc) is a set of asynchronous online courses and in-person field placements that prepare you to meet teacher licensure requirements. This 27-credit secondary education teaching licensure program is designed for students who already hold undergraduate or graduate degrees in an area outside of education.

- Two letters of recommendation: one should be from an undergraduate/graduate instructor or academic advisor and one should also be from a current employer.
