Requirements for HBS upper division status¹ (see list below)

- 1. Minimum GPA of 2.65 or higher. Transfer GPA can be used if all requirements are met prior to a GPA being established at SCSU.
- **2.** 45 earned credits. Includes all transfer credits and SCSU credits. Does not include developmental coursework.
- 3. Completion of the following: ACCT 291, HBS 111, ENGL 191, CMST 192, MATH 196
