GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF JOB

The Accreditation Coordinator provides advanced academic, technical, and administrative support for the university's institutional and specialized accreditation operations. The Accreditation Coordinator is responsible for developing and managing systematic processes, designing and maintaining information management architecture, and securing accreditor approvals for academic curriculum. The coordinator is responsible for regularly evaluating key processes and systems and preparing analytical reports that include proposals to enhance operational effectiveness and efficiencies. This position maintains currency and fluency in institutional accreditation standards, policies, and procedures and serves as an accreditation operational specialist for the university.

Minimum Qualifications (expected to have to enter job):

- One year of experience performing operational analyses, determining recommendations for improvement, collaborating on process change implementation, and monitoring resulting effectiveness and efficiency.
