I join with the Office of the Chancellor and the Diversity and Multiculturalism division to congratulate St. Cloud State University on winning the Diversity Mini-grant.

The purpose of this grant is to support research that will have a measurable impact on ways that colleges and universities can increase the number of students who are recruited, retained and graduated from traditionally underrepresented and American Indian communities.
