D2L Brightspace: Monitor Student Engagement and Progress

Brightspace Tutorials D2L Brightspace offers built-in tools that can help boost student engagement with course materials and help you monitor class progress within your course. You can setup criteria within the <u>Intelligent Agents</u> tool to automatically engage students based on activity levels, and use <u>Class Progress</u> feature within D2L Brightspace to view a variety of indicators for all students to help measure their progress within the course.

Zoom Passcode/Waiting Room Update



We previously learned and communicated that on September 27, 2020, Zoom would require that all meetings have a passcode or a waiting room enabled for Minnesota State users. Zoom has since updated this requirement, and it no longer applies to Minnesota State's Educationally Licensed accounts. However, meeting passcodes and waiting rooms are still recommended to prevent zoombombing.

IT Support Tip: Prevent Presentation Pop-Ups



You can modify your computer settings to prevent notifications such as chats, emails and more while presenting or screen-sharing. This can help reduce distractions and prevent private information from popping up unexpectedly.
