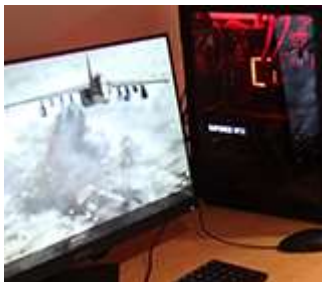
One-Day Sale for Employees - November 22nd

D2L Brightspace has a built-in Accessibility Checker to help ensure the content you author in Brightspace Editor conforms to [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\)](#) and [Section 508 accessibility standards](#). The Accessibility Checker is available within the Editor for use within Content, Widgets, Quizzes, Calendar, Assignments, Discussions and any other tools where a user can access the Editor.
