### Password-less Authentication for Office 365 Coming Soon



Faculty, staff and students using the Microsoft Authenticator app to log into Office 365 are now able to register for password-less authentication. Password-less authentication offers convenience and additional security as it's more difficult to inadvertently approve malicious attempts to access an account. Instead of requiring you to enter your password to gain access into your Office 365 account, it will share a pin number sent to your registered device that you enter into the Authenticator application to verify your identity.

## "Shifts" Resource Management Tool in Teams



ITS uses "Shifts" for student employment scheduling, and other departments on campus can too! Shifts can be configured to work with the university's pay periods and enables supervisors to set schedules, approve schedule changes and generate scheduling reports. Student employees can use this tool to view schedules, swap shifts and request or claim open shifts (with supervisor approval). This service is a tool available within Microsoft Teams and is free with St. Cloud State's Microsoft licensing agreement.
