Freeze on Nonessential Changes During Start of Fall Semester



ITS is preparing to effectively support Convocation week and the start of the semester, including ensuring that resources are available to assist with online course delivery, technology issues and more.

To limit service disruption during the start of fall semester, the MinnState and SCSU IT departments will not complete changes to technology services and systems that are not essential for business operations (e.g. look and feel changes) between Monday, August 14th, through Wednesday, August 30th, 2023.

Technology Changes in Select Classrooms



To support changing instructor needs and offer modernized classroom technology services, several classrooms were updated over summer:

- CH 494 Cameras & microphone added to support web conferencing services such as Zoom.
- CH 106 Modified to a "Zoom room" for easy Zoom scheduling and hosting.
- CH 4, 343, 352 and 498 Instructor cameras added to support teaching needs.
- ECC 118 and 120 Whiteboard cameras and laptop docking stations added.

New System for HR and Finance Processes Coming July 2024



Minnesota State is implementing <u>Workday</u> as the new tool to support the business process needs of payroll, HR, finance, procurement, student administration, finance and other functions.

The first phase of the Workday implementation includes replacing the Integrated Statewide Record System (ISRS) with Workday for HR and finance processes across Minnesota State. This first phase will go live in July 2024. SCSU employees can expect communications to ramp up over the academic year and training in spring.
