Modernizing technology services is critical to support the University's It's Time strategy and uphold our institutional mission to prepare our students for life, work and citizenship in the twenty-first century. Each month in 2023, we'll share highlights about technology modernization activities.

MyHuskyNet Portal: The MyHuskyNet portal, a tool offering students a single channel to easily access links and information important to their education, was recently moved to a modern platform with enhanced security features such

as Office 365 multi-factor authentication and Microsoft-led updates. The new portal also offers a new look-and-feel prioritizing the services that are important for Huskies today.

ISE Authentication: St. Cloud State is implementing Cisco Identity Services Engine (ISE) Authentication to improve the security and user experience for people connecting via ethernet to our network. ISE Authentication creates a more efficient authentication process by allowing people to use StarID credentials to access the network without having to register devices.

Regularly updating and restarting your devices improves their functionality. Employees should review and complete needed updates for University-issued computers through the Software Center (Windows computers) or SCSU Self-Service (Mac computers).
