To Prepare for Class



Send the Zoom link to students, with an agenda, their preparation requirements and your netiquette expectations.

Useful Zoom Features for Students



Login 10 minutes prior to class.



Sign in to Zoom <u>minnstate.zoom.us</u> using your StarID and password.

Recording:



Test your audio, webcam and screen share. How to Record



Check your Zoom settings and choose Record and choose Cloud Option.

During Class






Check student mute/unmute.

Ensure students in overflow room can hear audio and see screen share.

Ask students to post questions in Chat.

After Class







End Session in Zoom.

Log out of the classroom system; mic and camera will turn off once you log out. If you recorded your session, check your Kaltura MediaSpace - you can share the recording in D2L.
