What is CGI U?

The Clinton Global Initiative University (CGI U) is the higher education program of the Clinton Foundation that supports undergraduate and graduate students across the world who **commit to take action** to address pressing global challenges of the 21st century.



CGI U history

As part of the Clinton Foundation, former U.S. President Bill Clinton started the Clinton Global Initiative (CGI) in 2005 to bring together leaders and organizations across sectors and countries who made "Commitments to Action" to address pressing challenges.

Building off the successful model of CGI, CGI University (CGI U) became the higher education extension of the Clinton Global Initiative in 2007.

CGI U hosted its first annual meeting at Tulane University in 2008. It has hosted an annual meeting in partnership with a different college or university ever since as a way to bring together its annual student cohort.

Every year, undergraduate and graduate students apply to CGI U with their own Commitments to Action. Each year, approximately 600 students are selected to participate in the CGI U year-round program.



What is a Commitment to Action?

Through CGI U, students are asked to make a new, specific, and measurable human-centered commitment that addresses a pressing challenge. So what are we looking for?



New

Commitment addresses an unmet need or aims to solve a well-known problem in a new and unique way.



Specific

Commitment should have a defined course of action, detailed objectives, and a realistic timeline.



Measurable

Commitment should make an impact in ways that are measurable and can be reported.



Examples of impactful commitments







Lucky Iron Fish

Commitment to produce a cooking tool that infuses meals with iron to help prevent and treat iron deficiency.

Focus Area: Public Health

Agro360

Commitment to use artificial intelligence that analyzes the condition of crops to improve agricultural productivity.

Focus Area: Environment and Climate Change

ScholarJet

Commitment to increase access to STEM education and experiential learning through scholarships.

The phases of developing a commitment

SCALING

IDEATION

The process of forming and relating ideas.

About **50%** of CGI U students are in the ideation phase.

IMPLEMENTATION

When all of the planning and strategy that you have worked on during ideation moves from concept to action.

About **30%** of CGI U students are in the implementation phase.

After implementating your initial idea, scaling is the process of using the details and strategies that you have learned to replicate and expand your commitment.

About **20%** of CGI U students are in the scaling phase.

Peterson Foundation's Up to Us Campus Competition


A program for students in the U.S. to lead campaigns on their campus that emphasize building a more sustainable economic and fiscal future for the next generation.
