#### AN INVITATION

You are cordially invited to nominate students for participation in the 2020 Springfest High School Honor Band. <u>Dr. Lauren Reynolds</u> (University of Delaware) and Todd Prout (Melrose High School) will be your clinicians. All participants will also be able to work with guest composer <u>Benjamin Dean Taylor</u>. You and your students will not want to miss this opportunity! *Encourage pianists and string bass players to apply!* 

Up to two bands of select high school performers will be assembled as the clinic performance ensembles. Directors may nominate students online at the form located at <a href="https://scsu.mn/2TTPYUK">https://scsu.mn/2TTPYUK</a>.

Nominations should be completed as soon as possible, but no later than **Friday, February 21**. **Directors** may nominate any outstanding student in grades 9-12 that would benefit from this experience. There is no limit for the number of students that may be nominated. Directors will be notified of decisions regarding student participation on or around <u>March 2</u>. Students will be selected based on 1) Director recommendation and 2) Instrument needs for each ensemble.

Early registration bonus! Directors may be eligible for prizes, including gift cards for music or other equipment from our sponsors, for directors who nominate students before February 21.

The participation fee for all accepted students is \$35 per student and is due at registration on April 14. This fee includes lunch as well as a Springfest t-shirt.

#### FOR STUDENTS

A full day of activities will take place for participating students, including full ensemble rehearsals, sectionals with St. Cloud State University faculty, performances by SCSU ensembles, and performances by the clinic ensembles. NOTE: Students should apply only if they can fulfill the responsibilities of the entire Springfest Honor Band, including rehearsals and concerts. Students will not be excused for activities outside of the Honor Band.

#### FOR DIRECTORS

Directors will not want to miss the opportunity to attend clinics given by Dr. Lauren Reynolds, Benjamin Dean Taylor and SCSU Music Faculty. In addition, you will want to attend the open rehearsals of the Honor Bands and the concert given by the St. Cloud State University Wind Ensemble at 3 p.m. at the Finale Concert at 5:30 p.m.

The culminating activity for students, directors, and the public will be a concert on Tuesday evening at 5:30 p.m. in Ritsche Auditorium on the St. Cloud State University campus. Tickets will be on sale at the door for \$5 for adults, \$3 for students and seniors.
