

St. Cloud State University 2015-2016 LGBT Pride Community Housing Addendum

Refer to the St. Cloud State University (SCSU) Residence Hall Application and Agreement 2015-2016 for terms and considerations related to the binding agreement. This addendum to the Housing Agreement presents the terms and conditions by which a SCSU student agrees to abide when residing in the "LGBT Pride Community", an All-Gender housing community during the 2015-2016 year. Bathrooms in All-Gender housing include a toilet and shower stall shared between two suite-style units. This addendum does not alter or replace any terms, conditions or obligations noted in the Housing Agreement.

If you occupy a space in All-Gender Housing during the 2015-2016 year, in addition to the Housing Agreement, the following will apply:

- The student will agree to all the provisions within the All-Gender Housing Addendum.
- The All-Gender Housing option allows any student to live with any other student in the designated suites, as determined by the Department of Residential Life.
- The student must self-select the All-Gender Housing option, by completion of the addendum, in order to be assigned to the designated community. Completion of the addendum does not guarantee placement or assignment to the community.
- The student must be an undergraduate student, at least 18 years of age, and eligible for University housing as defined by the Department of Residential Life.
- The student has the option to request a specific roommate.
- If the student wishes to live in All-Gender Housing, but does not request a particular roommate, the Department of Residential Life will assign a roommate, without consideration of gender, based on their Housing Application and the Housing Addendum.
- If a roommate cancels their Housing Agreement and/or moves out of the room/suite for any reason, the Department of Residential Life will assign the vacant space, without consideration of gender, to an eligible student. If the space cannot be assigned, then remaining students may be asked to relocate to other suites, per the terms of the consolidation policy as noted in the Department of Residential Life Student Handbook. Every effort will be made to reassign eligible students to other vacancies in the All-Gender housing community. If remaining roommate(s) can identify a new student to fill the vacancy, they need to contact the Department of Residential Life to determine their eligibility.
- Vacancies in suites will be treated as All-Gender if the occupants of the suite originally filled the space as an All-Gender space. If the suite or apartment that experiences a vacancy was designated as a single-gender space before the vacancy, then the gender designation of the space will be maintained and the unit will not be treated as an All-Gender space.
