






Do you rent in the St. Cloud Area? By the St. Cloud Area, we mean within a 10 mile radius in and around St. Cloud.










Generally speaking do you consider yourself to be a Republican, Democrat, Green Party member, Independence Party member, an independent, or something else?






Political party by gender




How interested would you say you are in politics? Are you very interested, somewhat interested, not very interested, or not at all interested?




Political interest by gender




How often do you discuss political matters? Do you discuss them frequently, somewhat frequently, occasionally, rarely, or never?




Political discussion by gender




If the election were held today which presidential candidate would you vote for -Hillary Clinton, John McCain, Barack Obama, or someone else?




















In the past two weeks have you consumed 5 or more drinks in a row? (for males only)




In the past two weeks have you consumed 4 or more drinks in a row? (for females)
