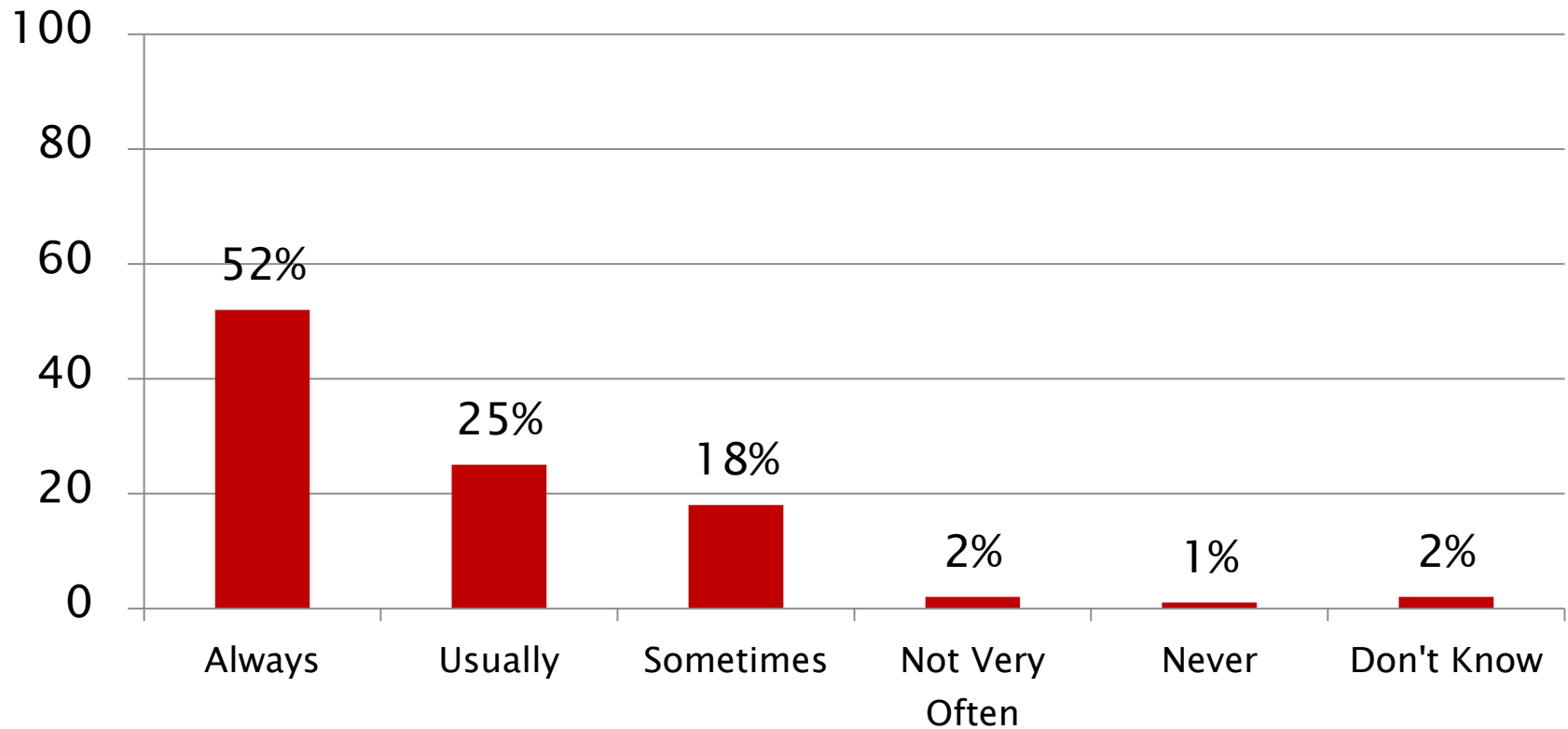

Do you always, usually, sometimes, not very often, or never feel proud to be a student at St. Cloud State University?

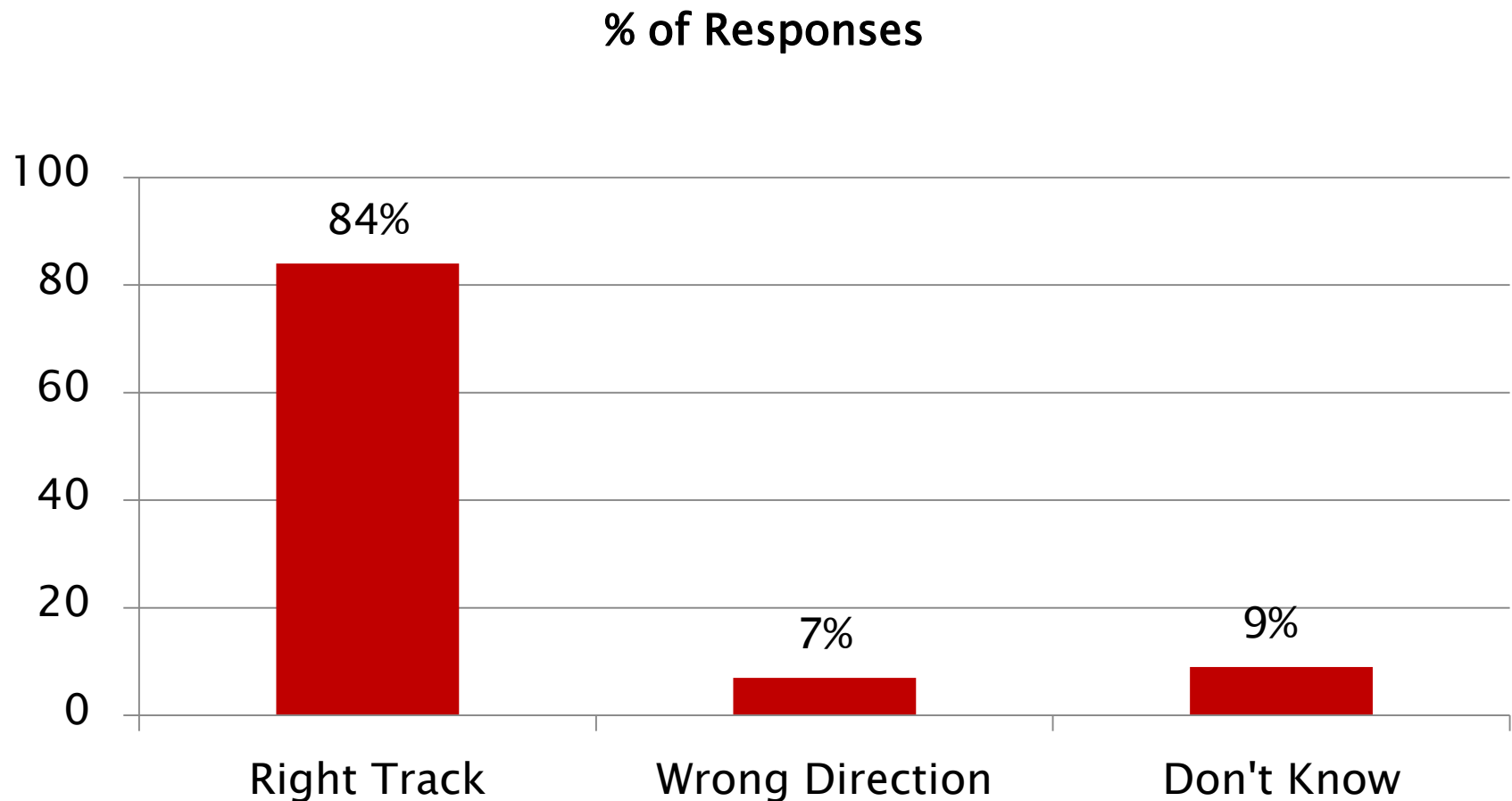

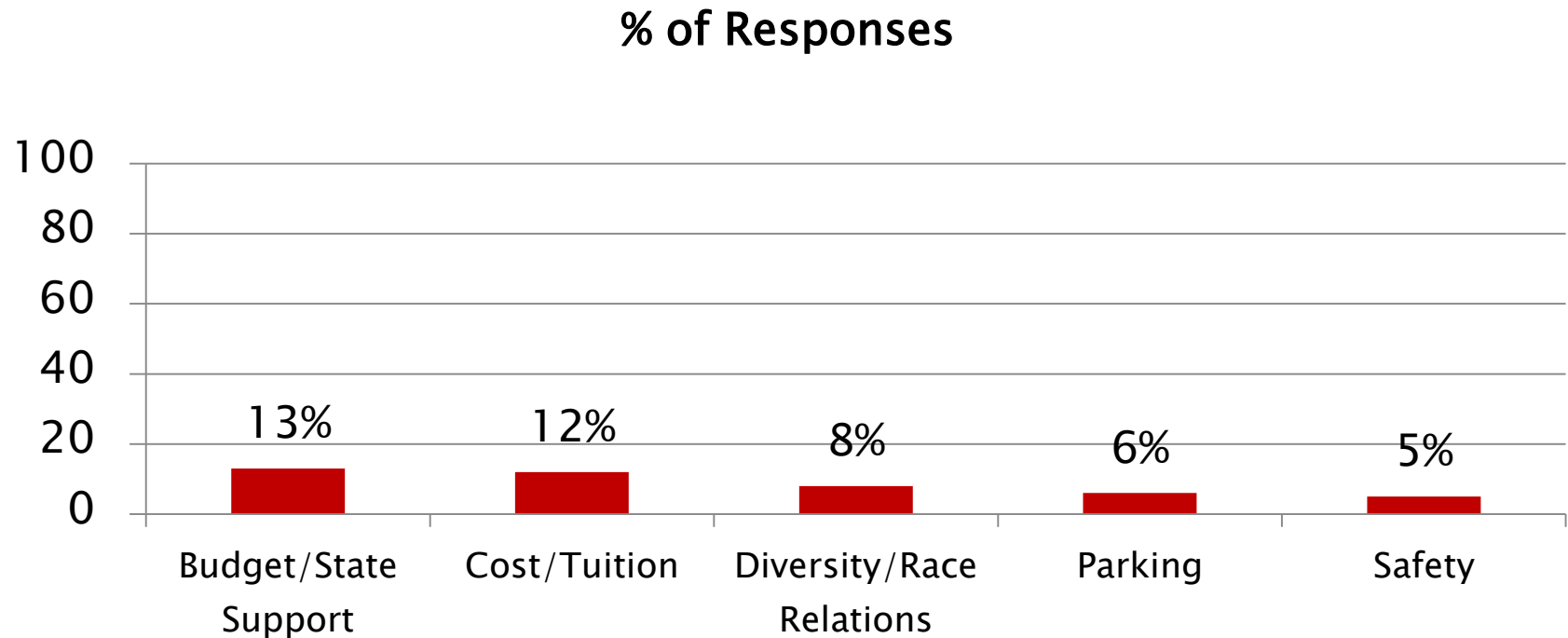

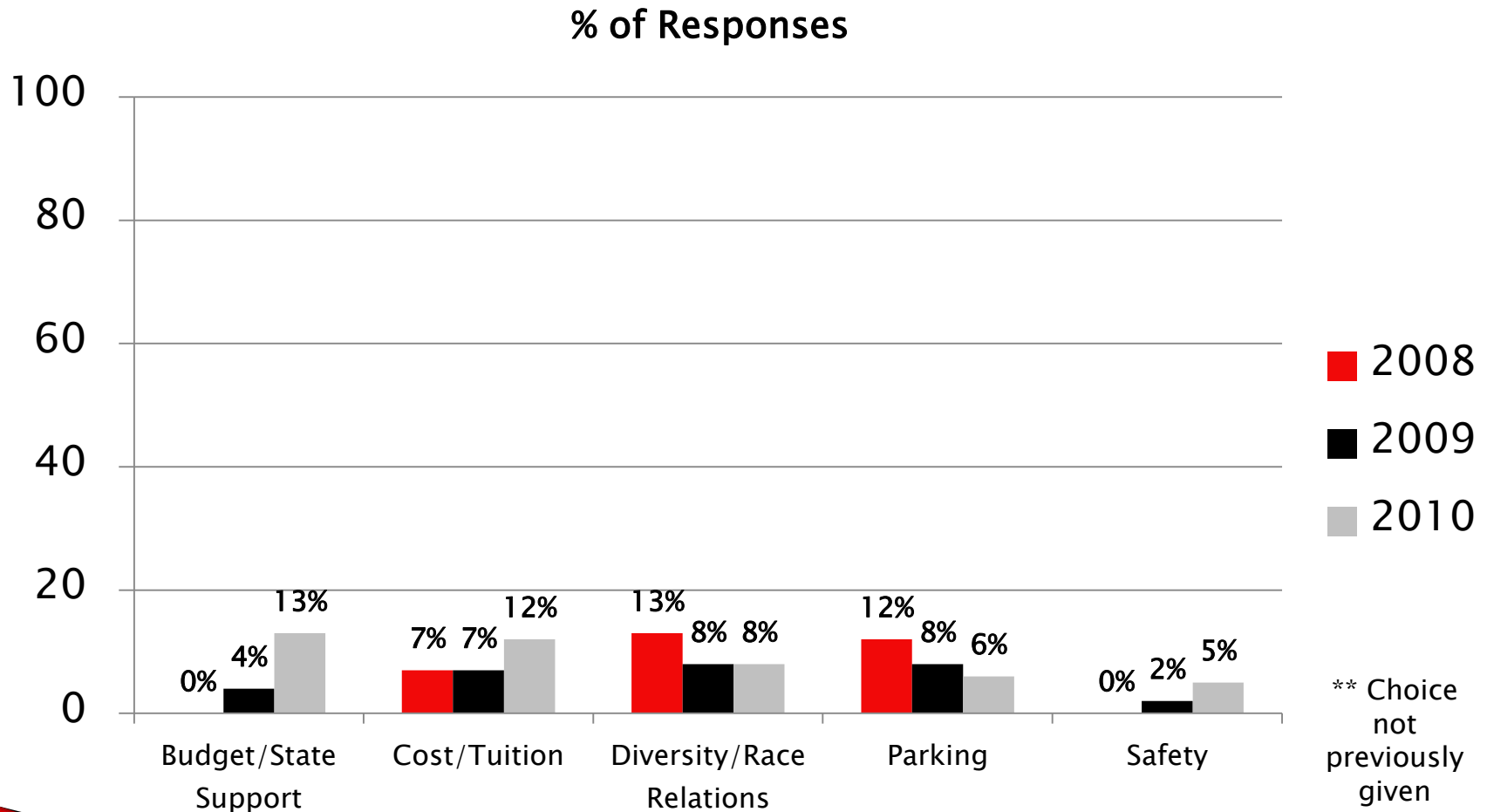

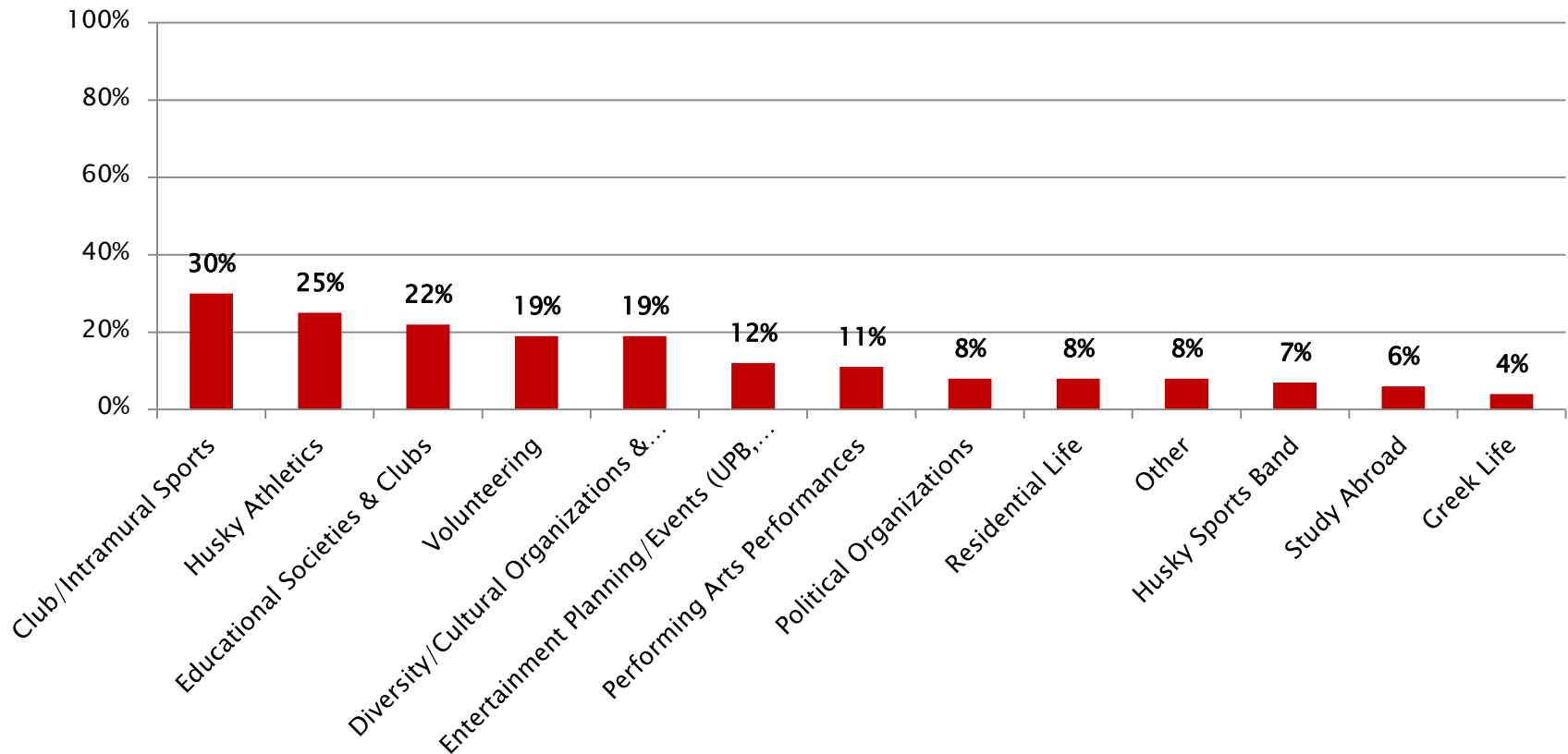

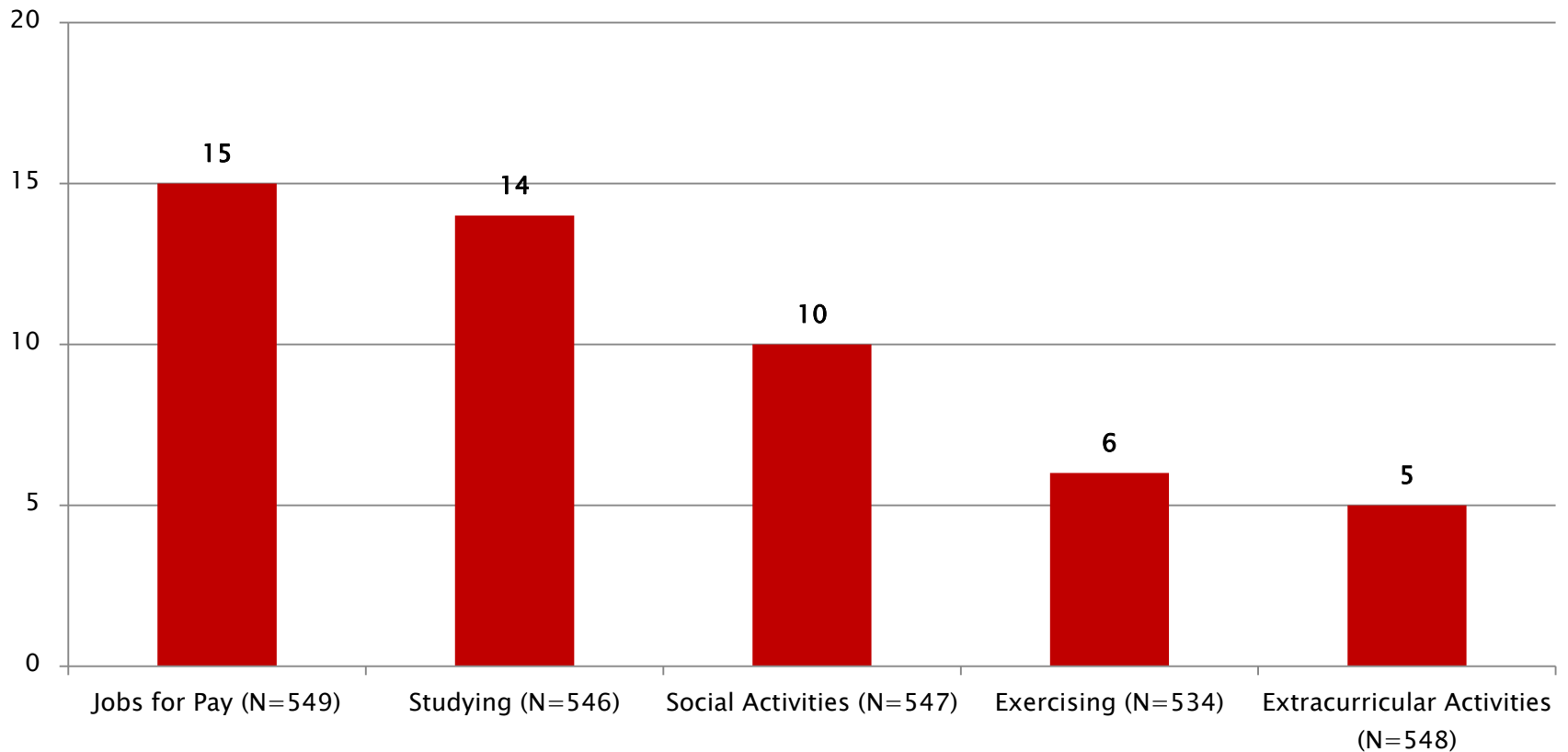
“What, if any, on-campus extracurricular activities do you participate in or attend?”

% of Respondents (Multiple Responses allowed)



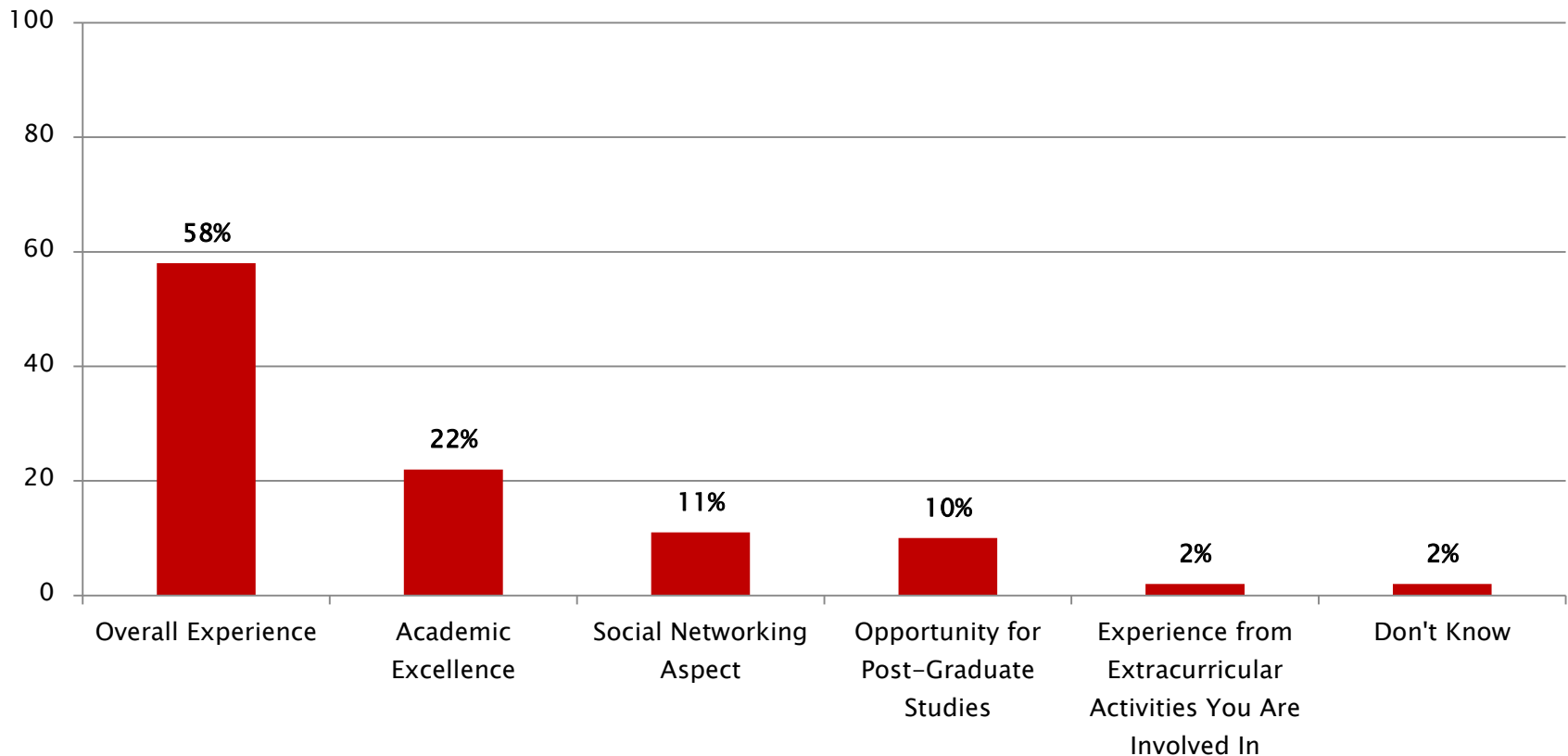
How many hours in a typical week SCSU students engage in certain activities

Average Amount of Hours



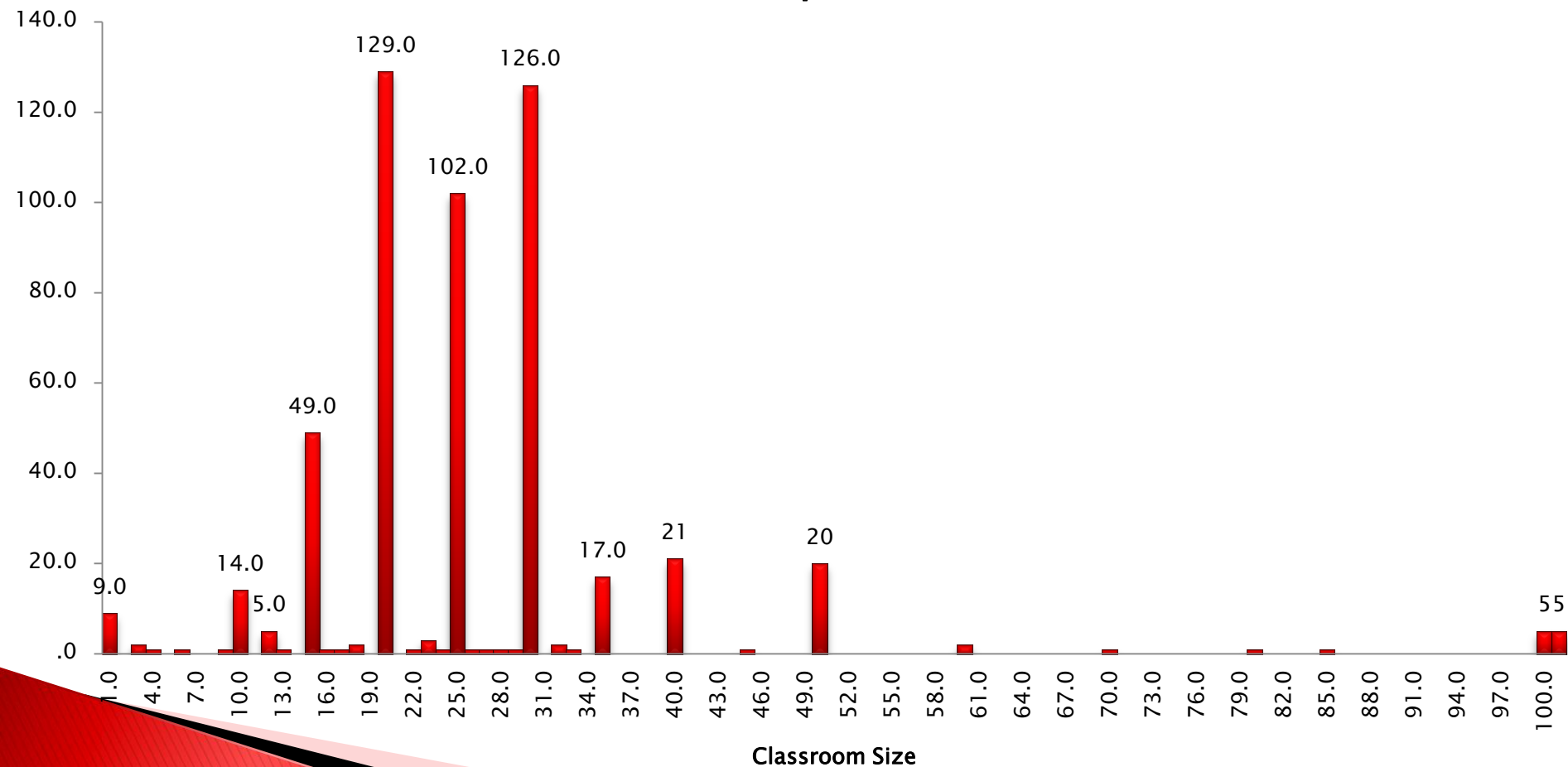
What part of college, other than future employment is most important to you?

In regards to class size, what number of students would you say is the best learning environment?

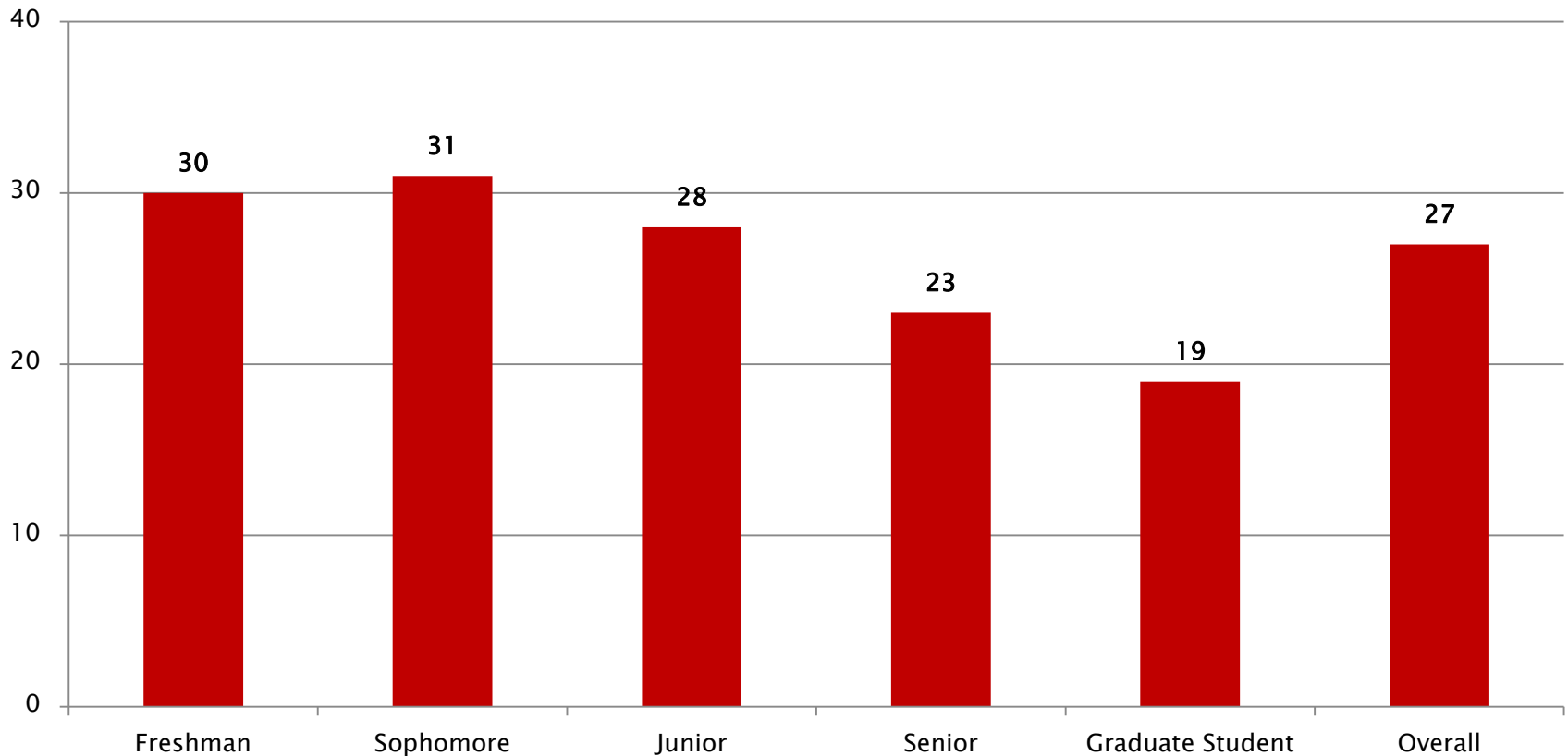

“In regards to class size, what number of students would you say is the best learning environment?”

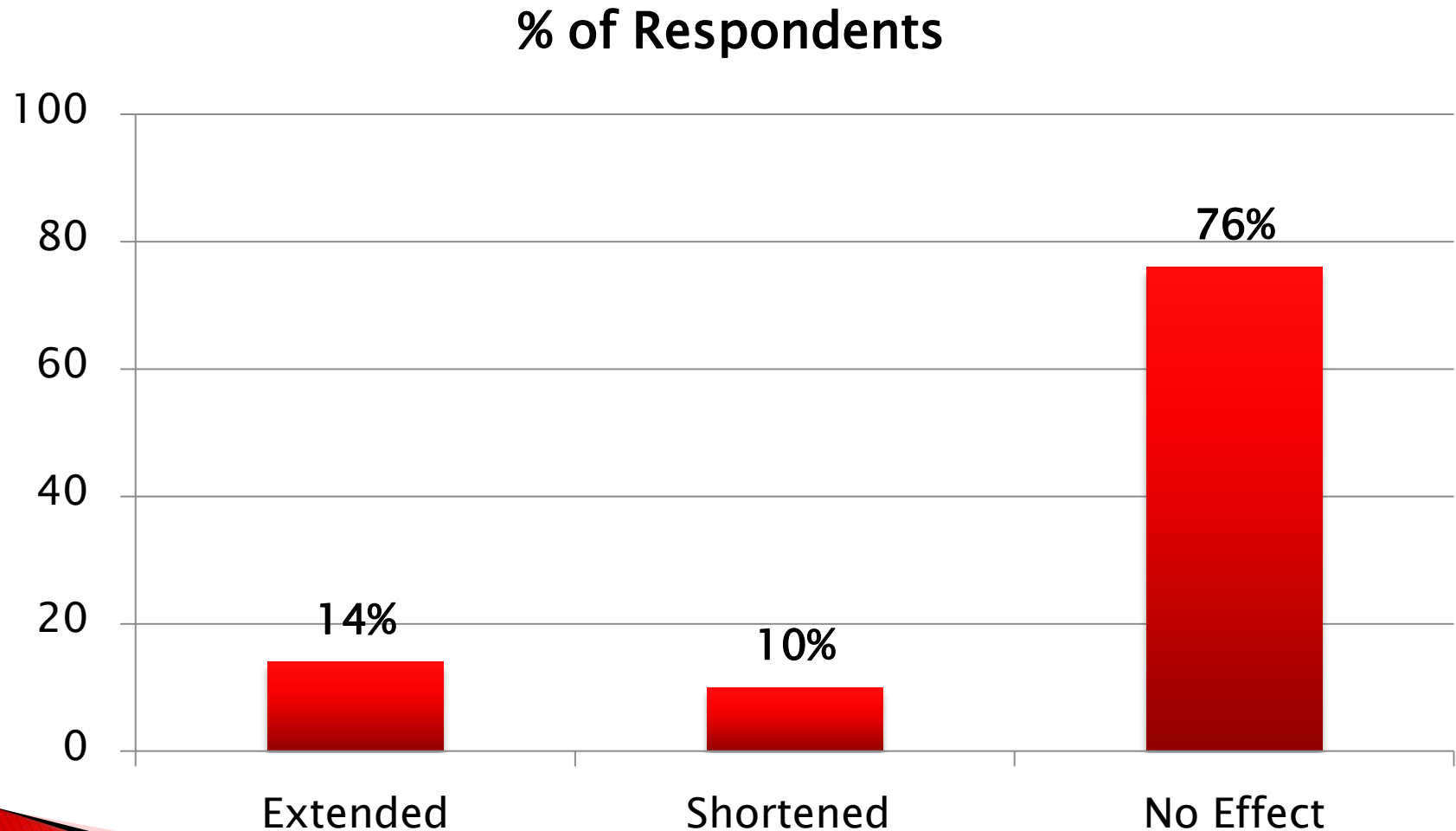
Average Class Size



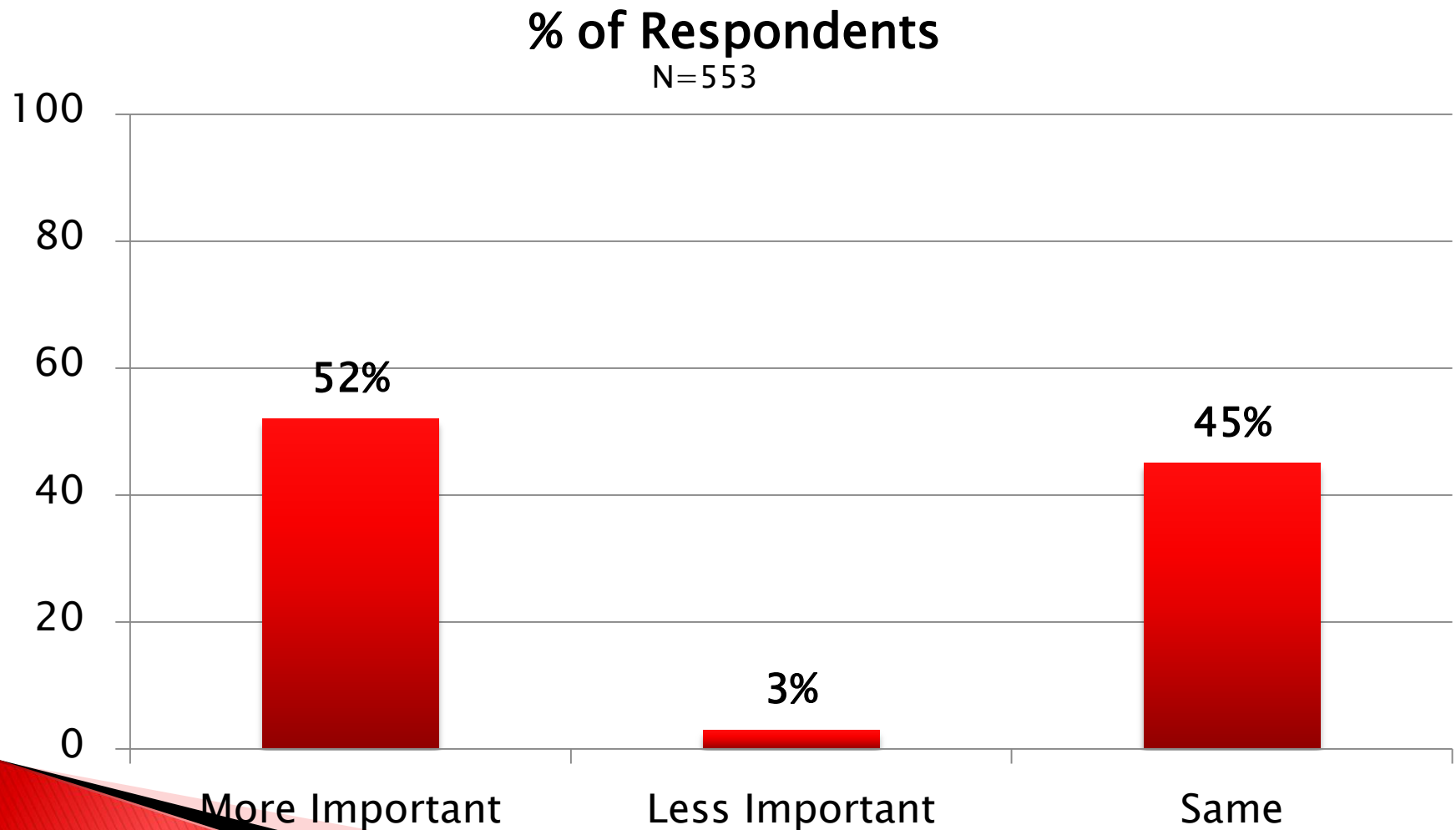

In light of the economic situation have you taken actions to extend or shorten your academic studies at SCSU, or has it not affected you?

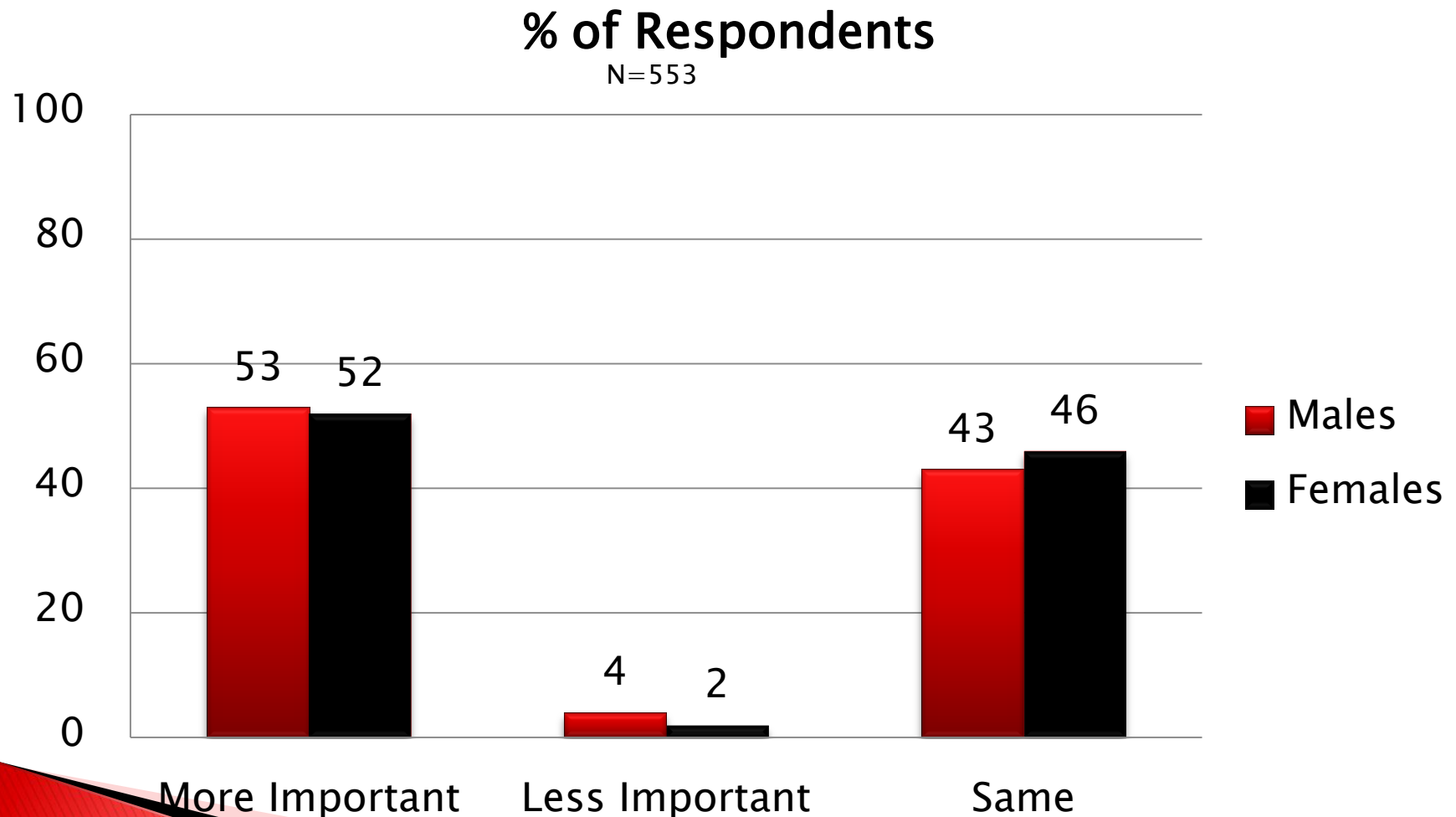


Do you think academic scholarships are more important, less important, or just as important as athletic scholarships?

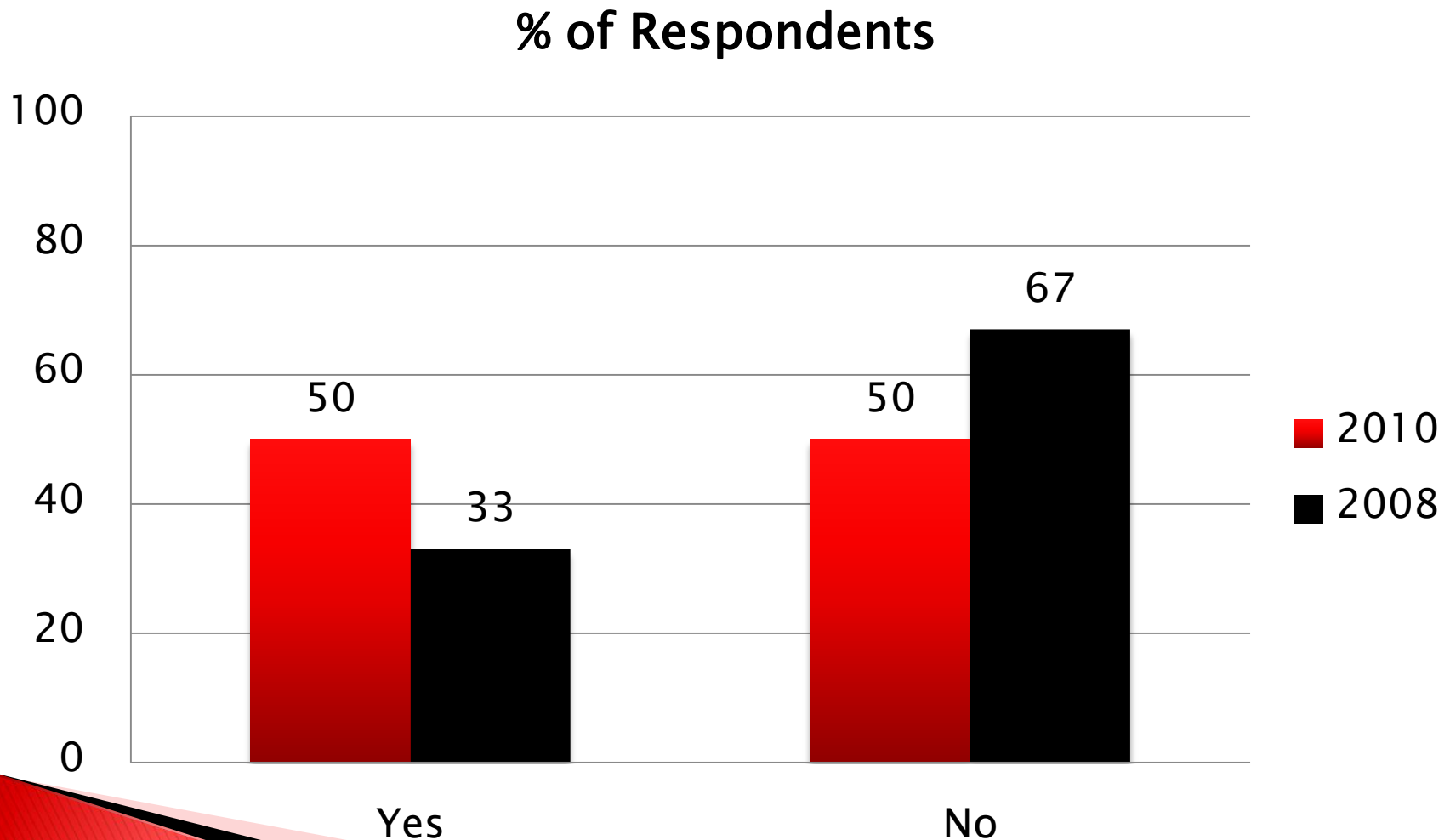
Do you think academic scholarships are more important, less important, or just as important as athletic scholarships?

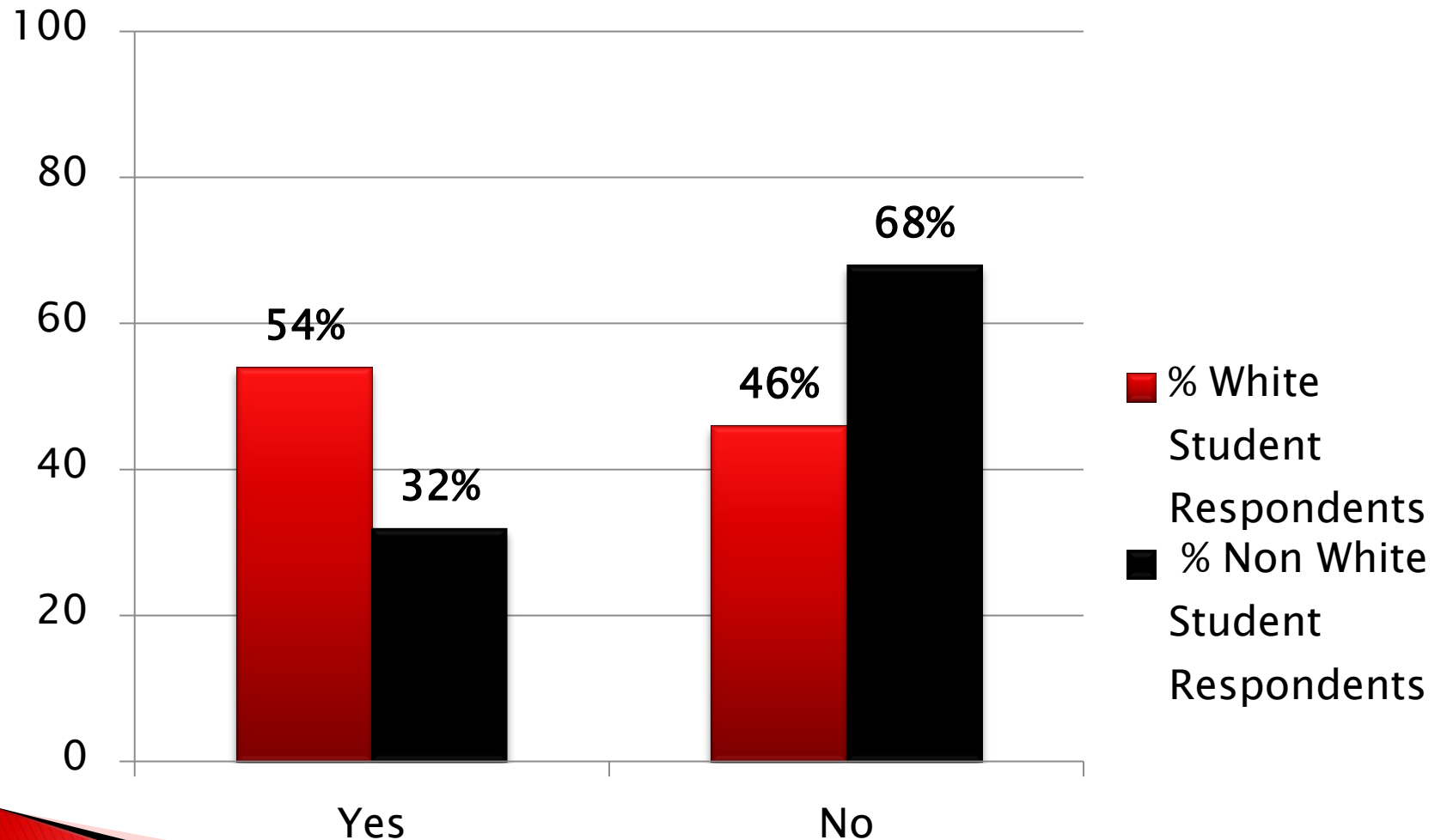
Have you taken an online class since you have been enrolled at SCSU?

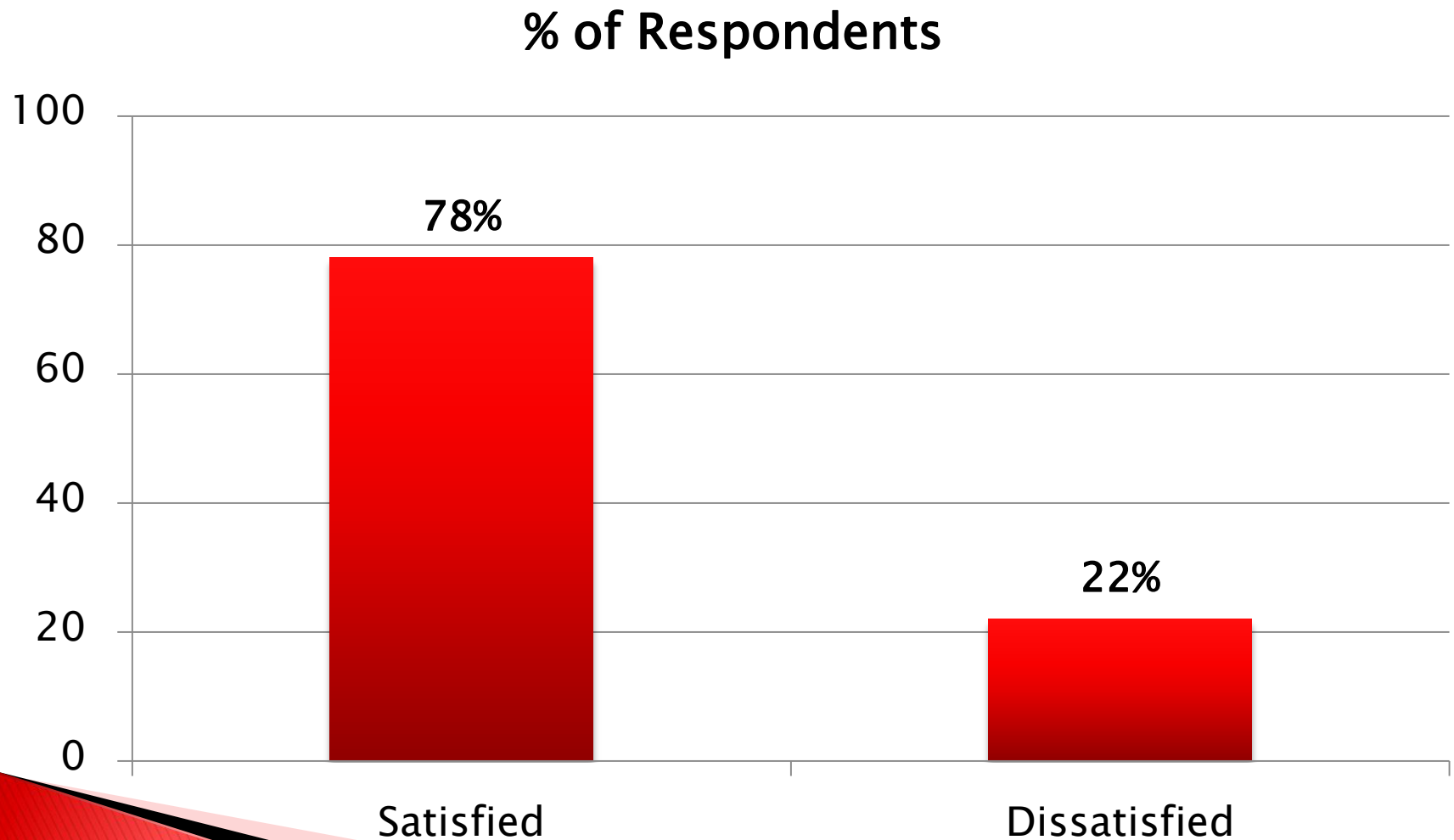

Overall would you say that you are very satisfied, somewhat satisfied, not very satisfied, or not at all satisfied with your online classes?



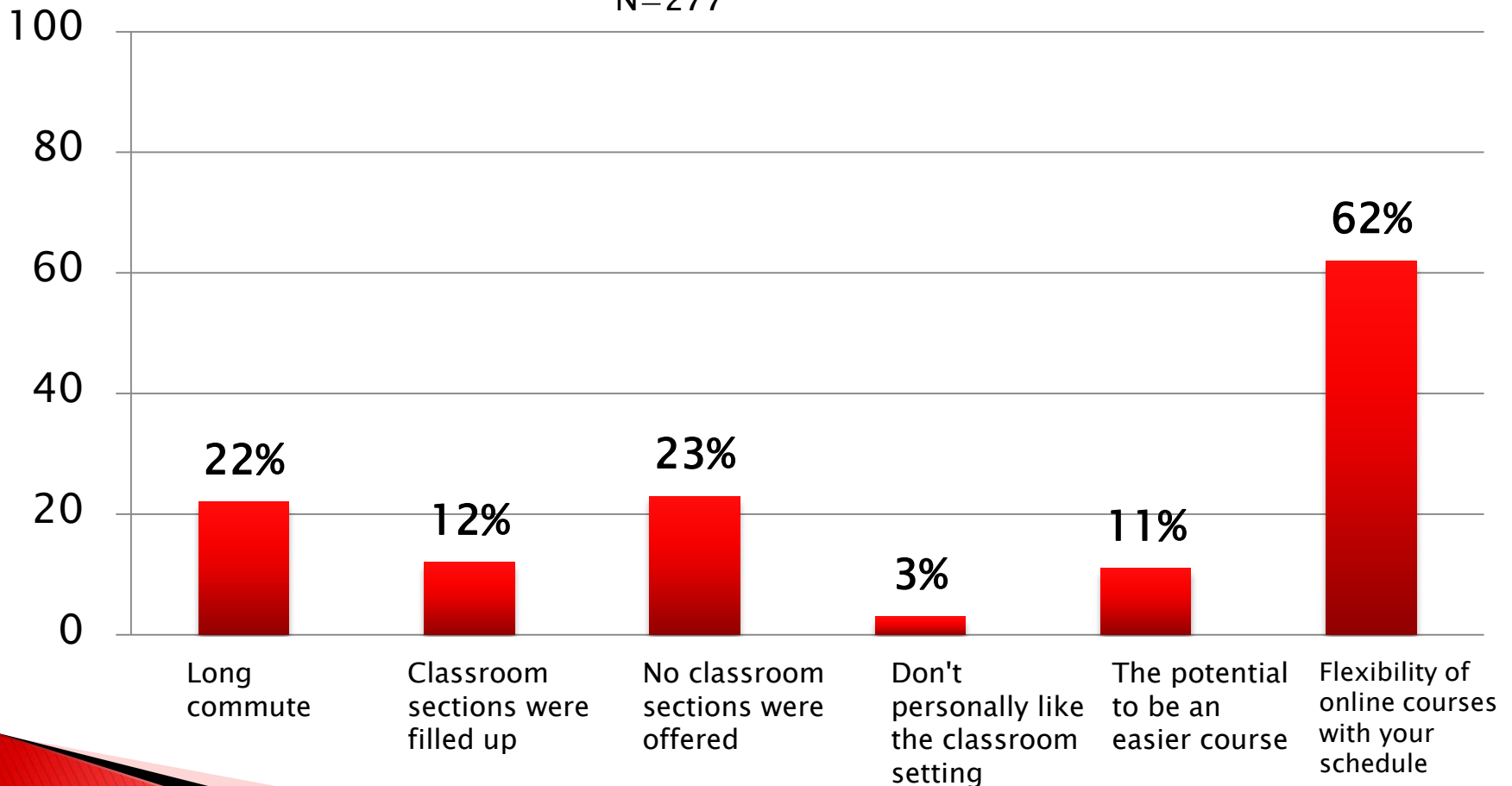

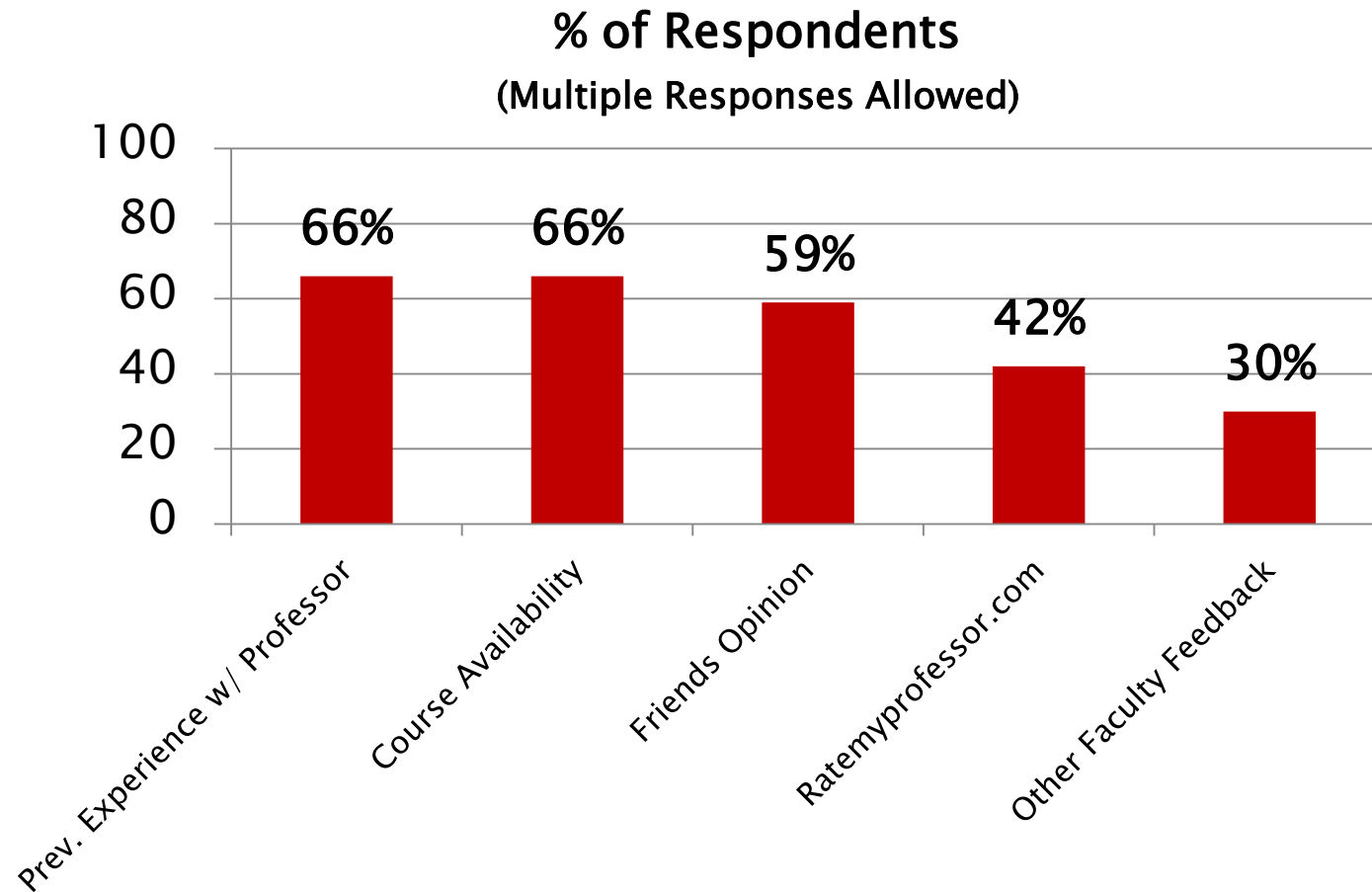

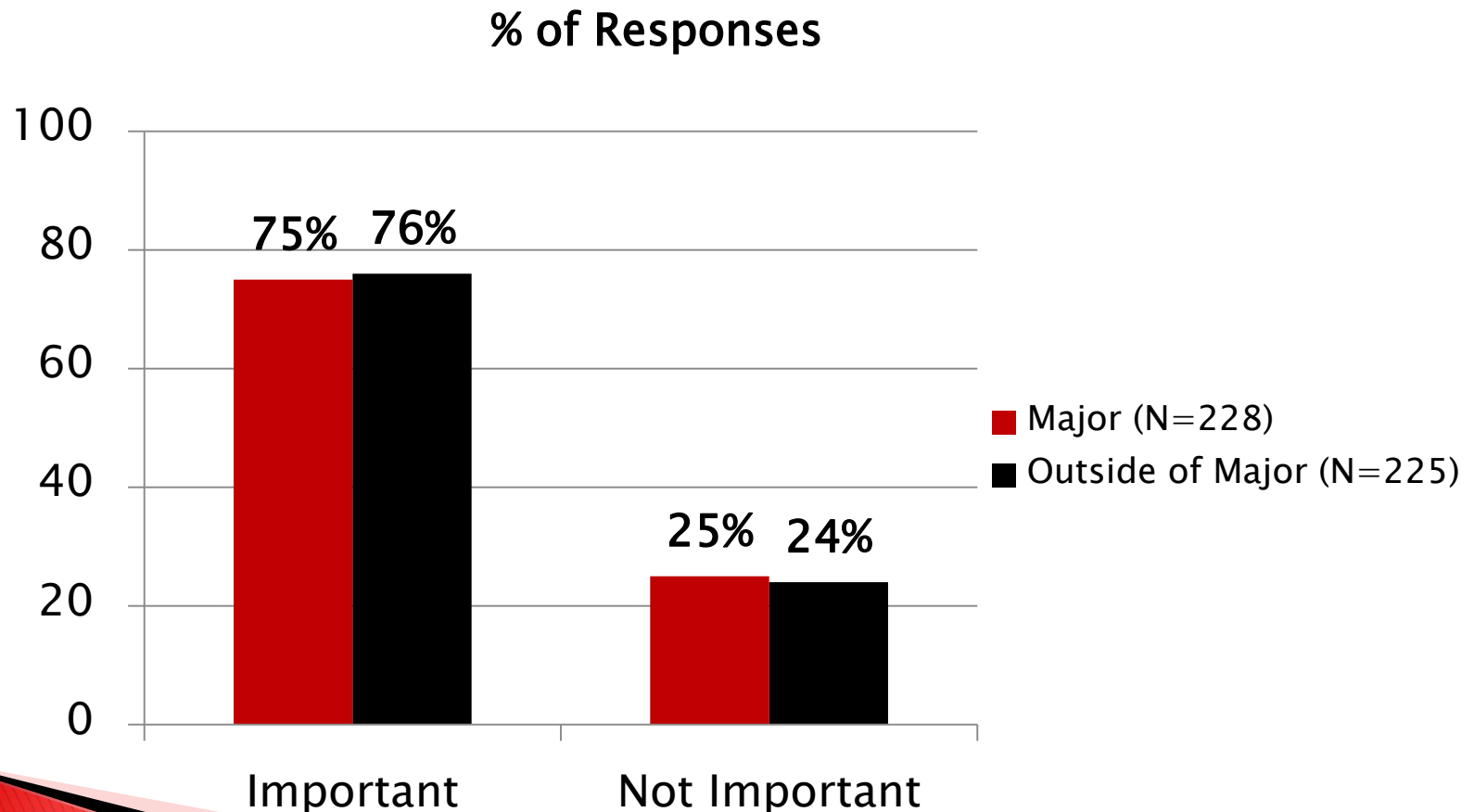

What factors help you choose what professor to take a course with?

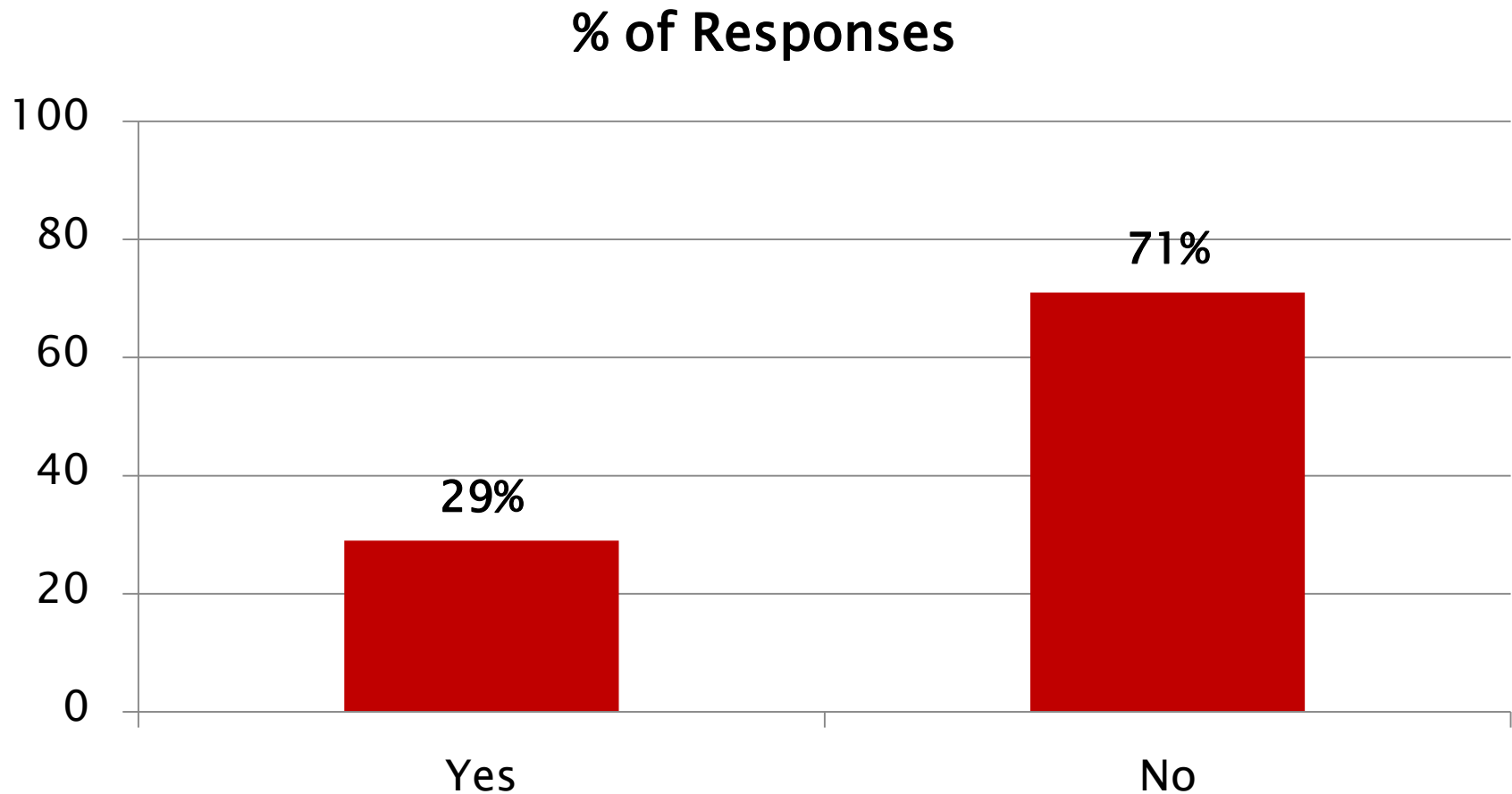

When using websites such as ratemyprofessor.com, how important are the websites' ratings and reviews when choosing classes...for your major vs. outside of your major

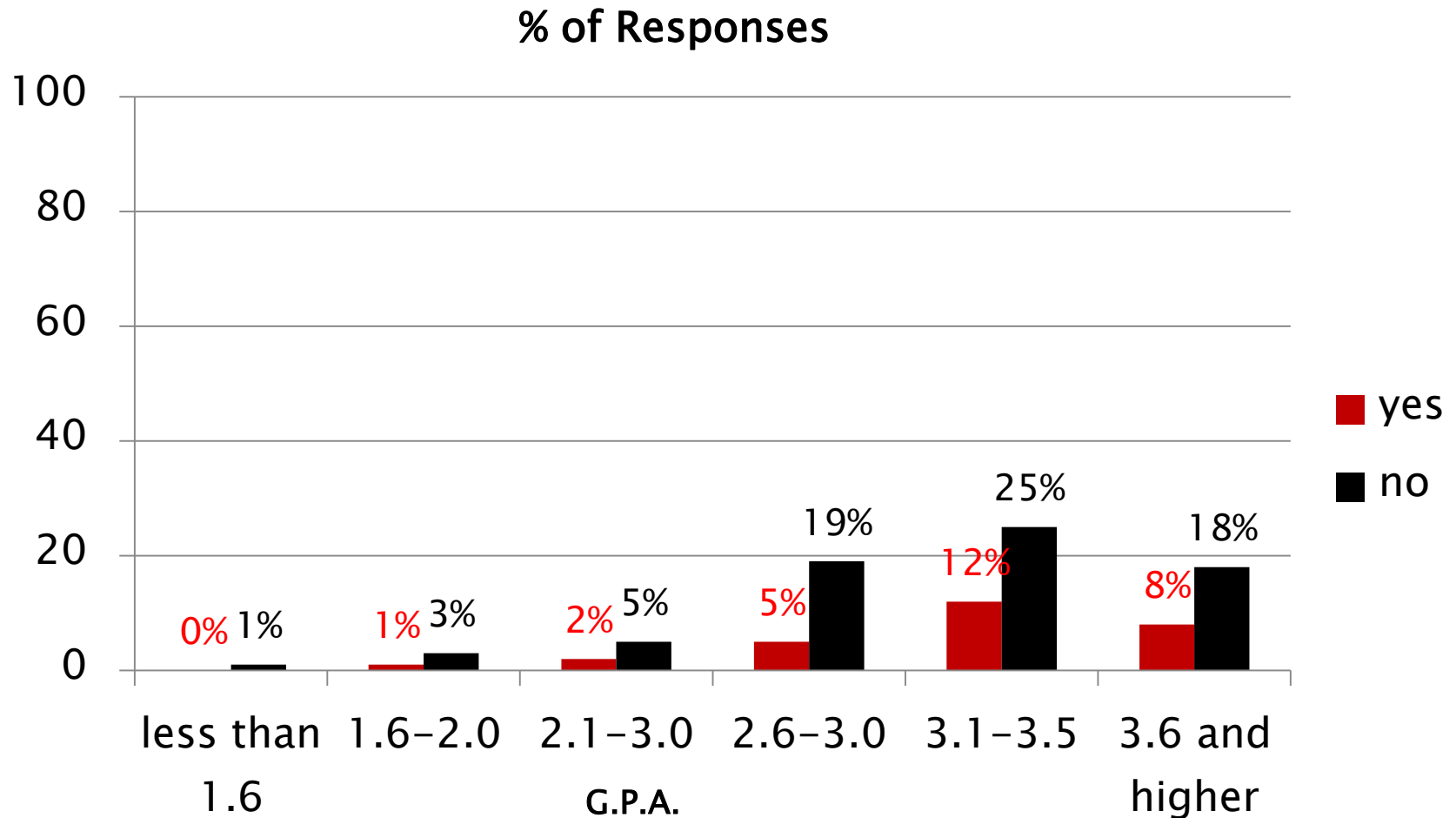


Have you ever submitted your own review of a professor on these types of websites?

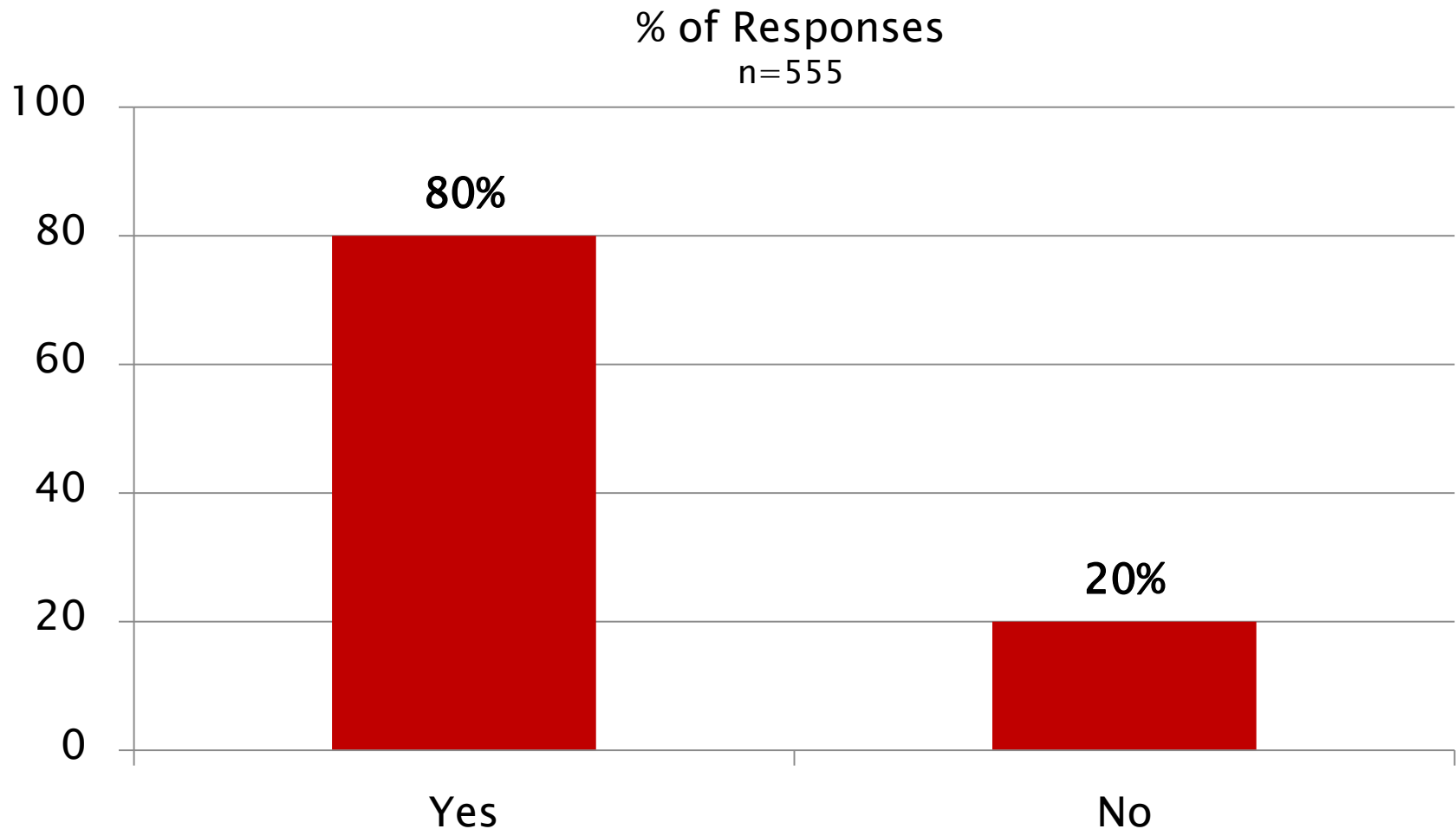

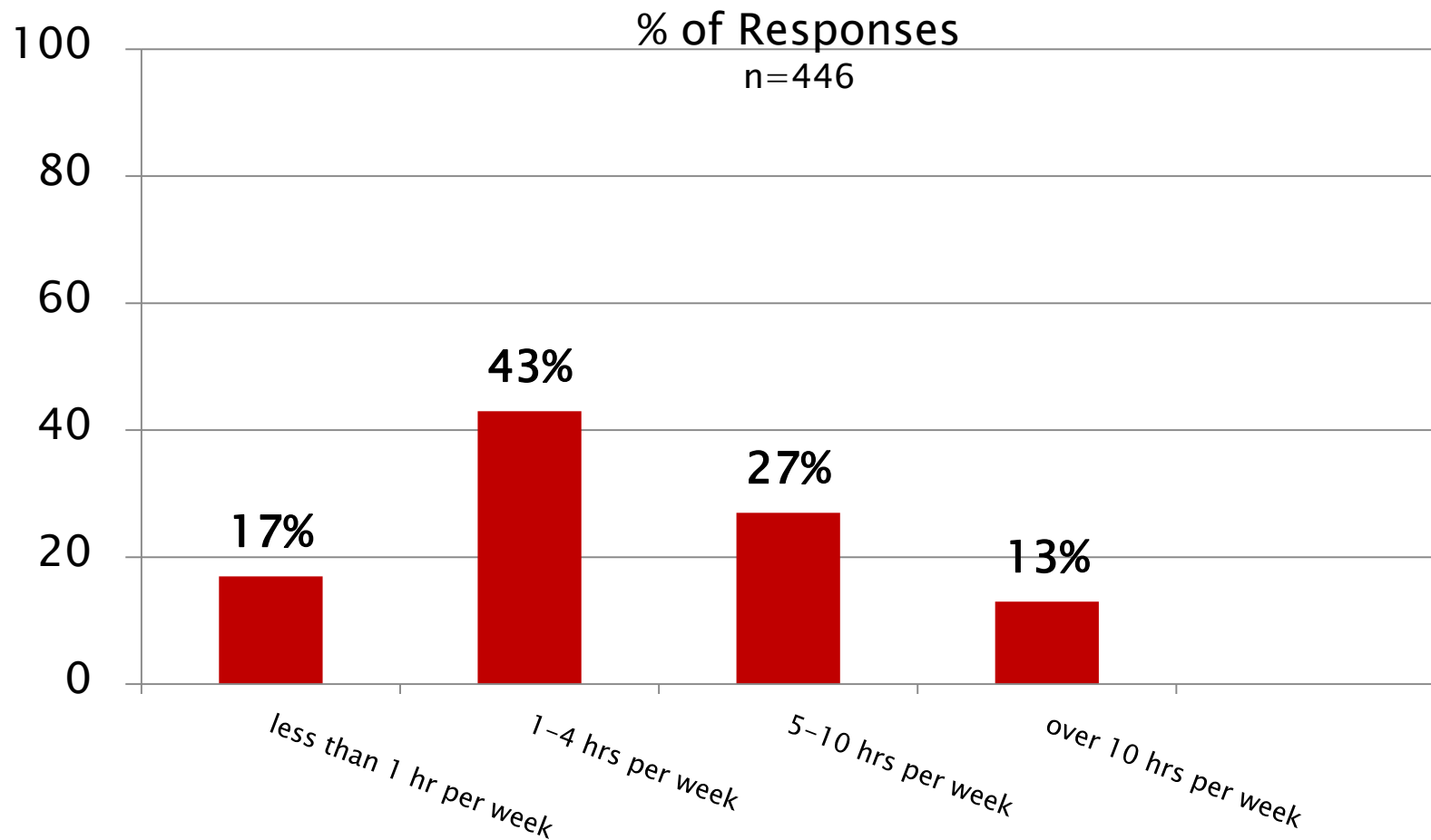

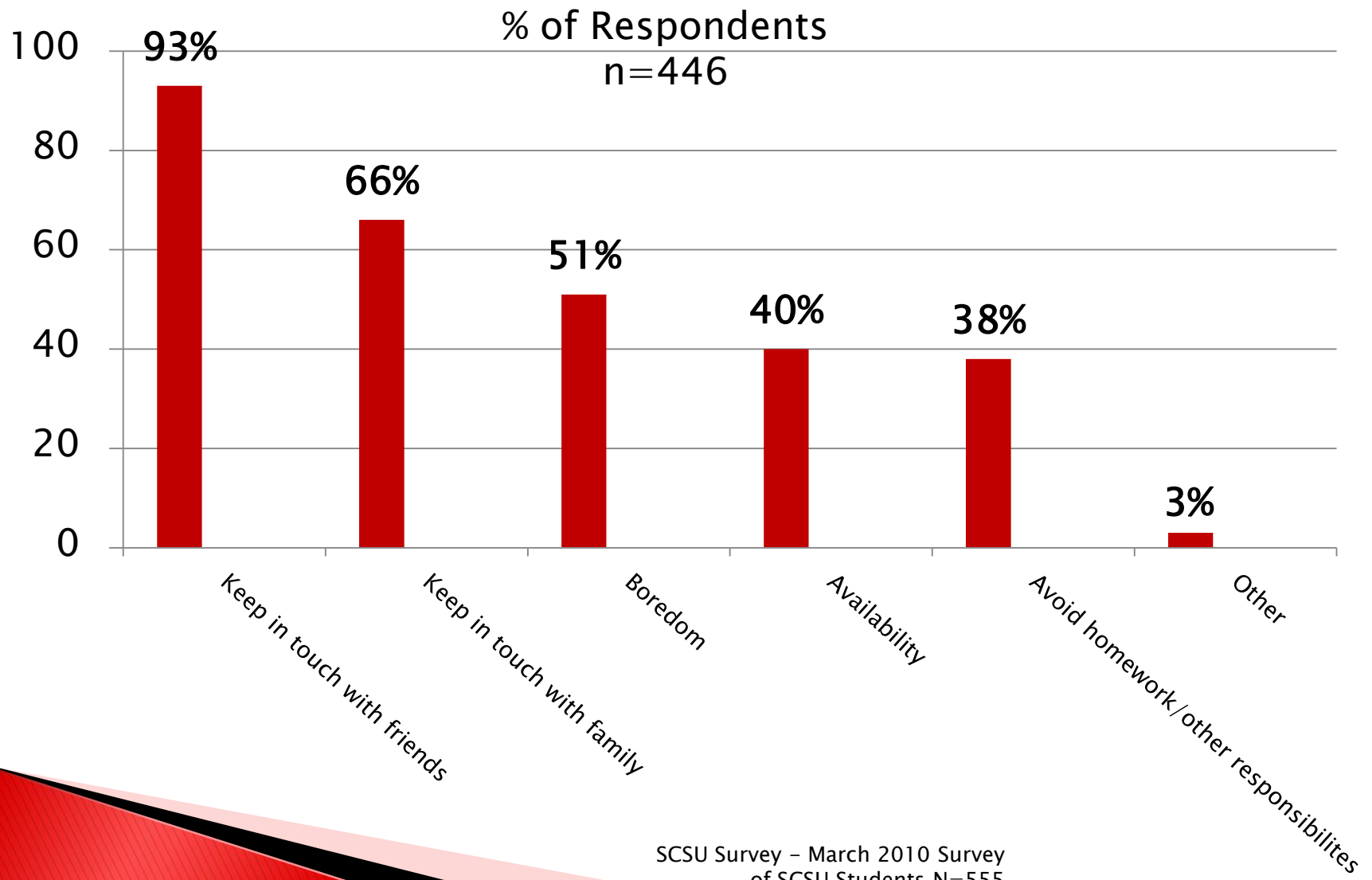
Do you use social networking sites?



If yes, how often do you use social networking sites per week?



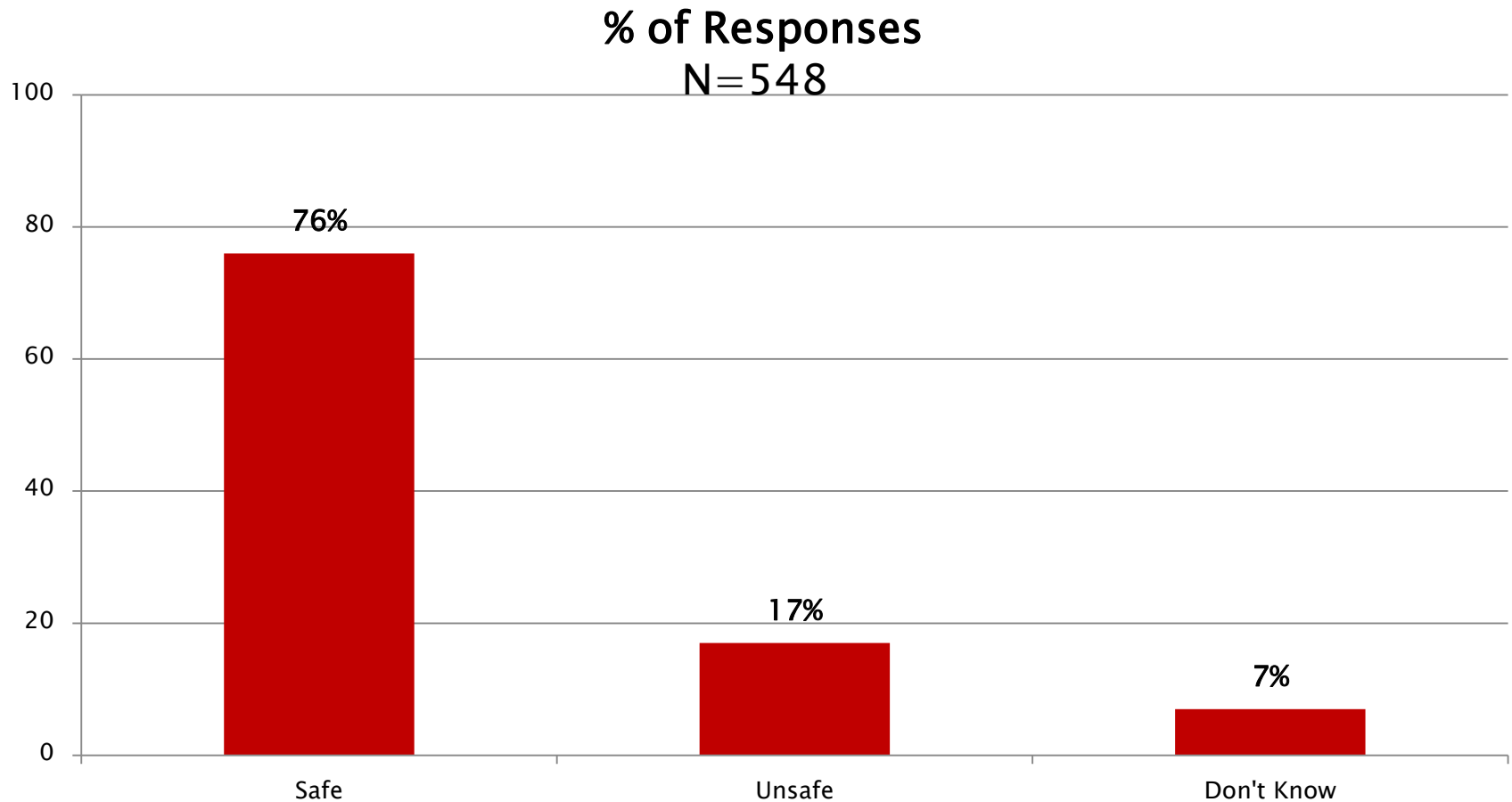
Why do you use social networking sites? (Multiple Response)

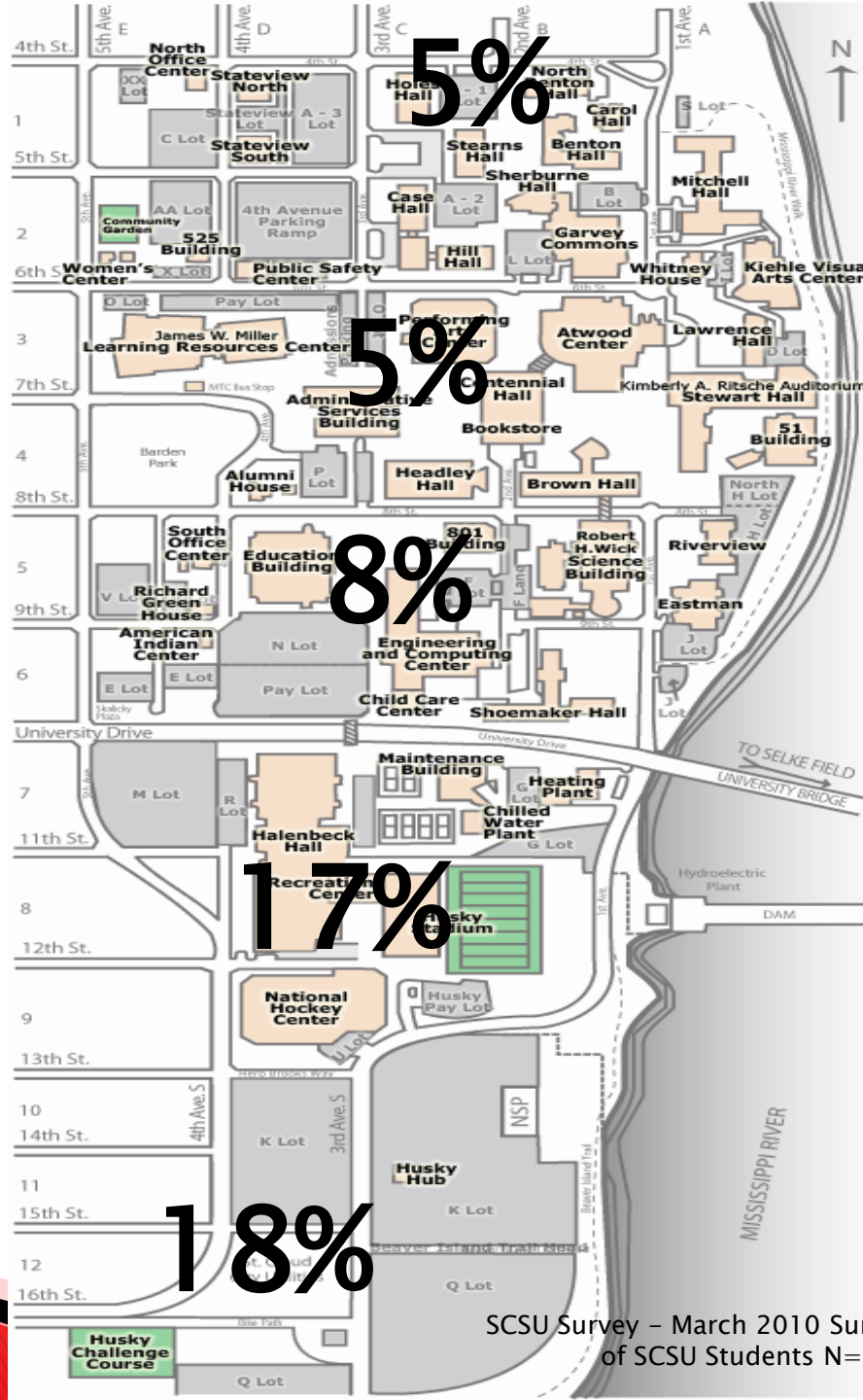
“When you are on campus after dark, do you generally feel very safe, somewhat safe, somewhat unsafe or very unsafe?”

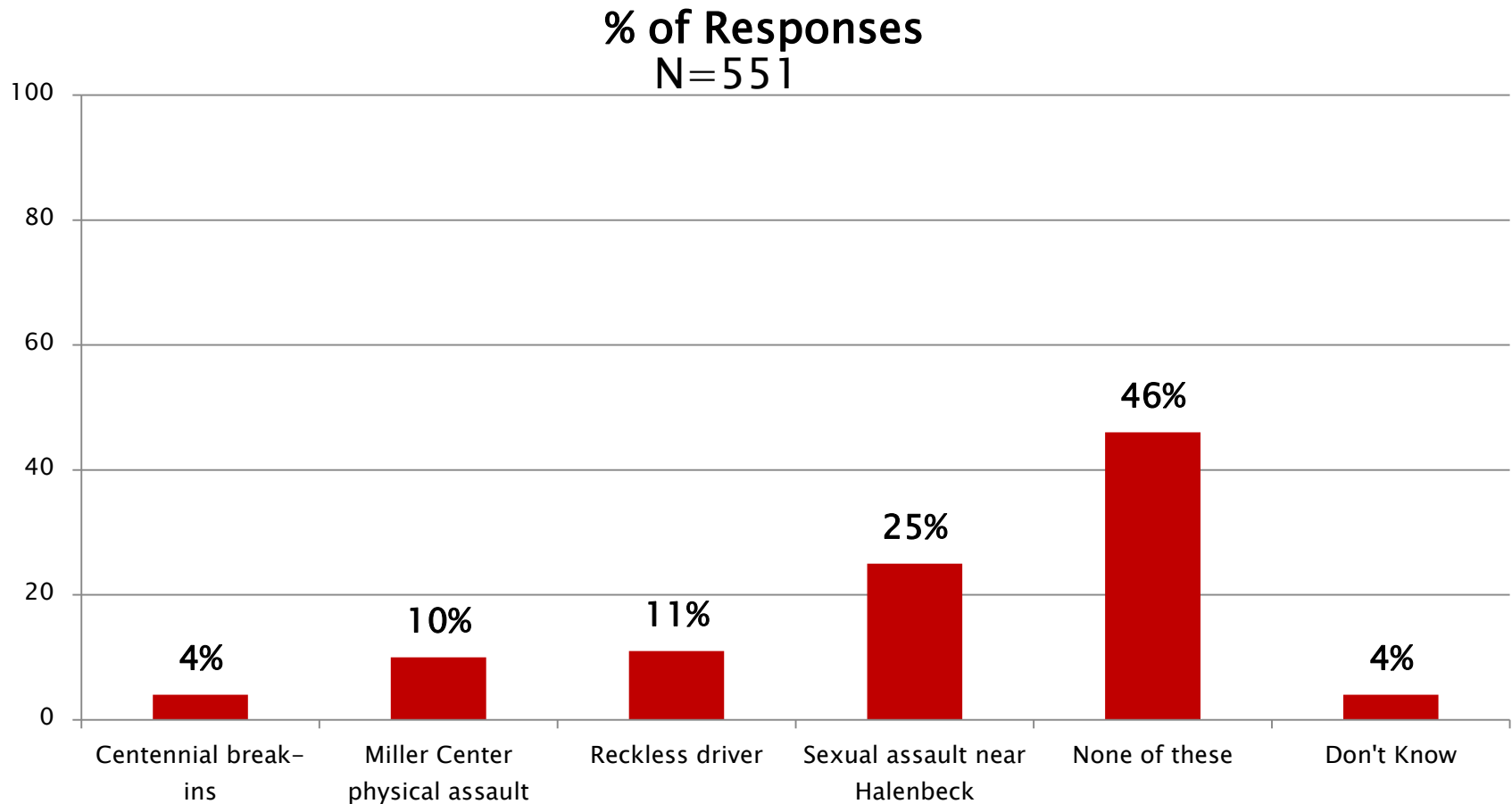

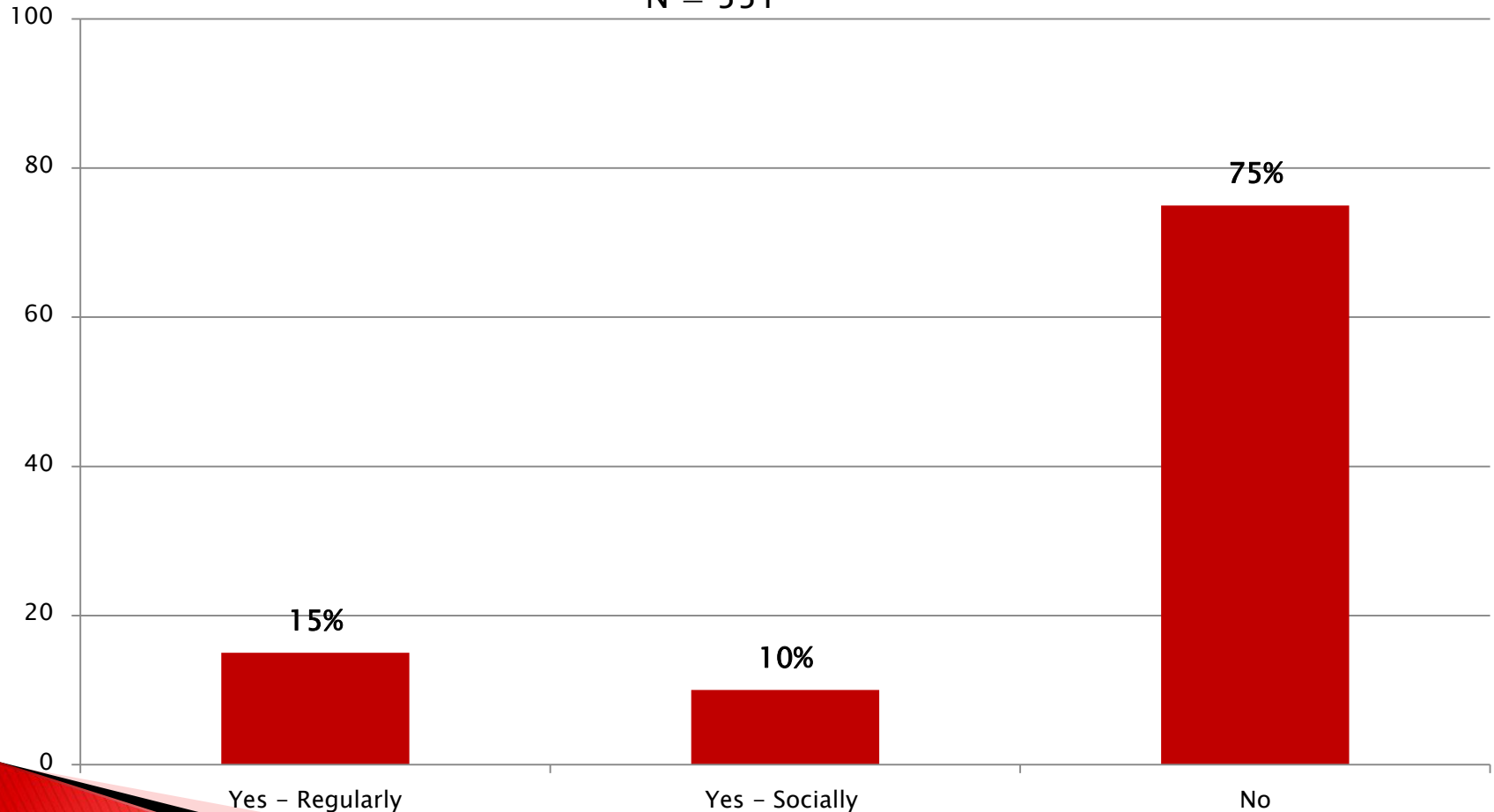

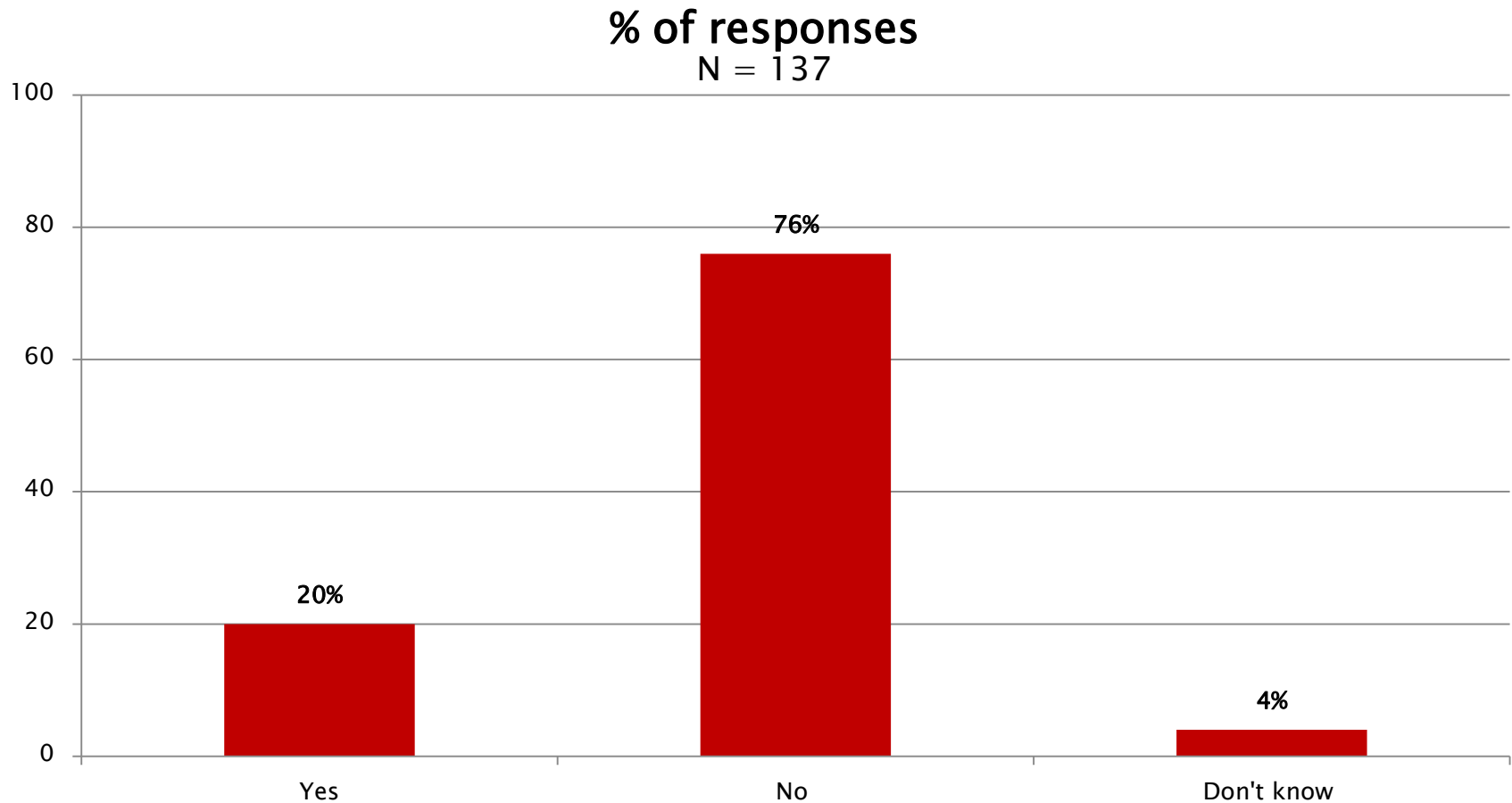
“Do you smoke cigarettes either regularly or on a social basis?”

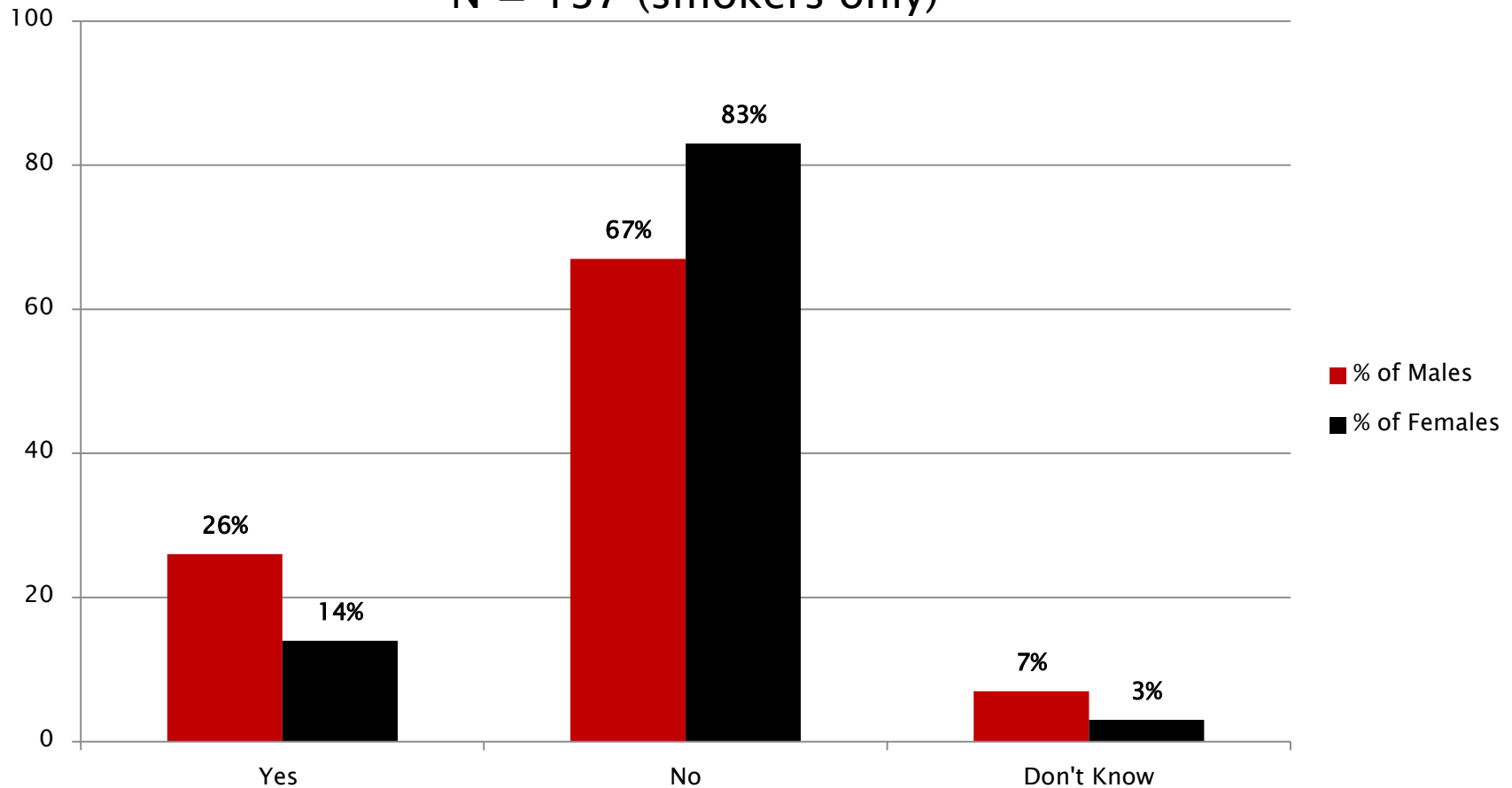

“Would a campus wide smoking ban deter you to use smokeless forms of tobacco such as chewing tobacco or vaporizers?”

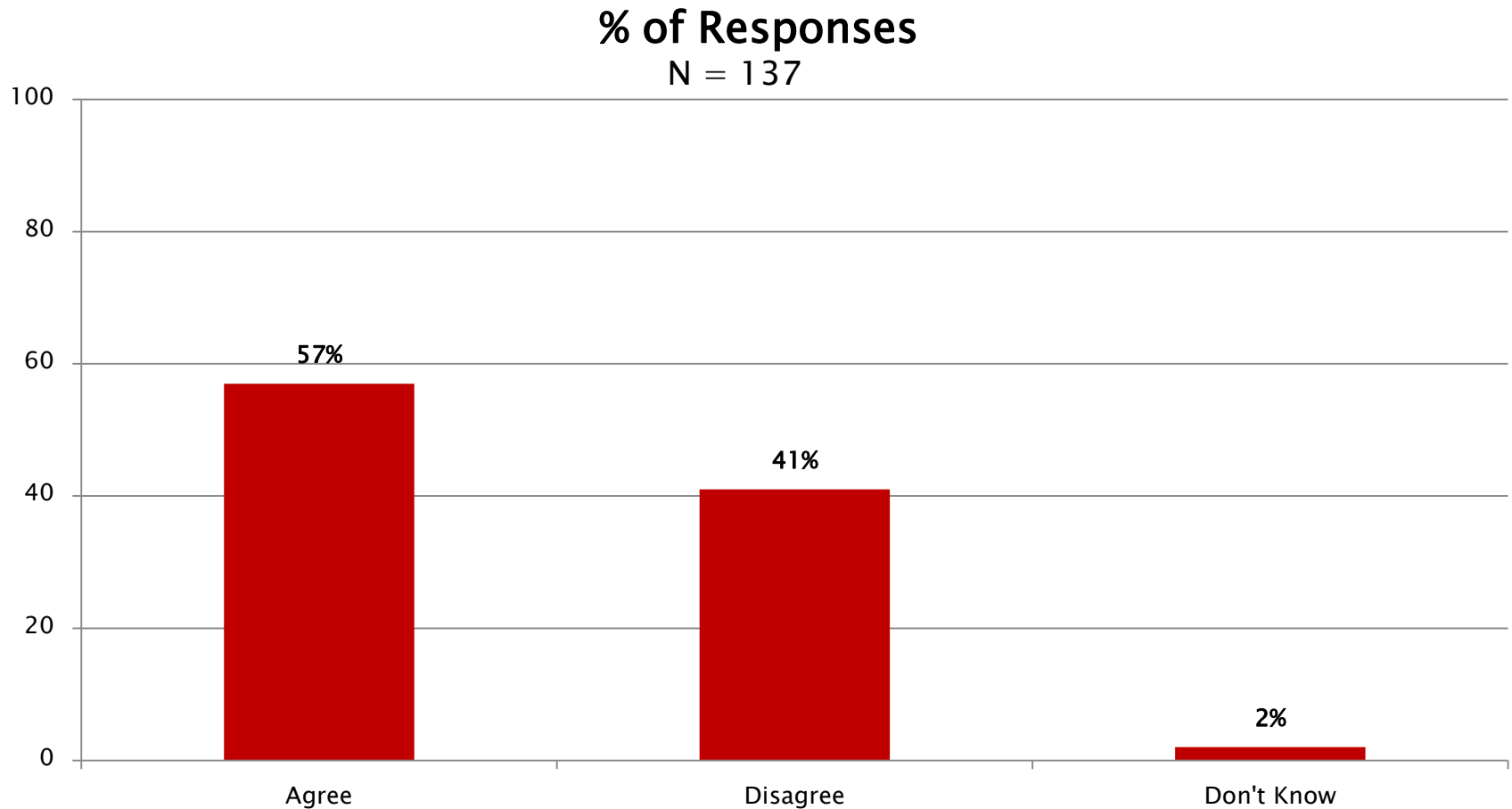

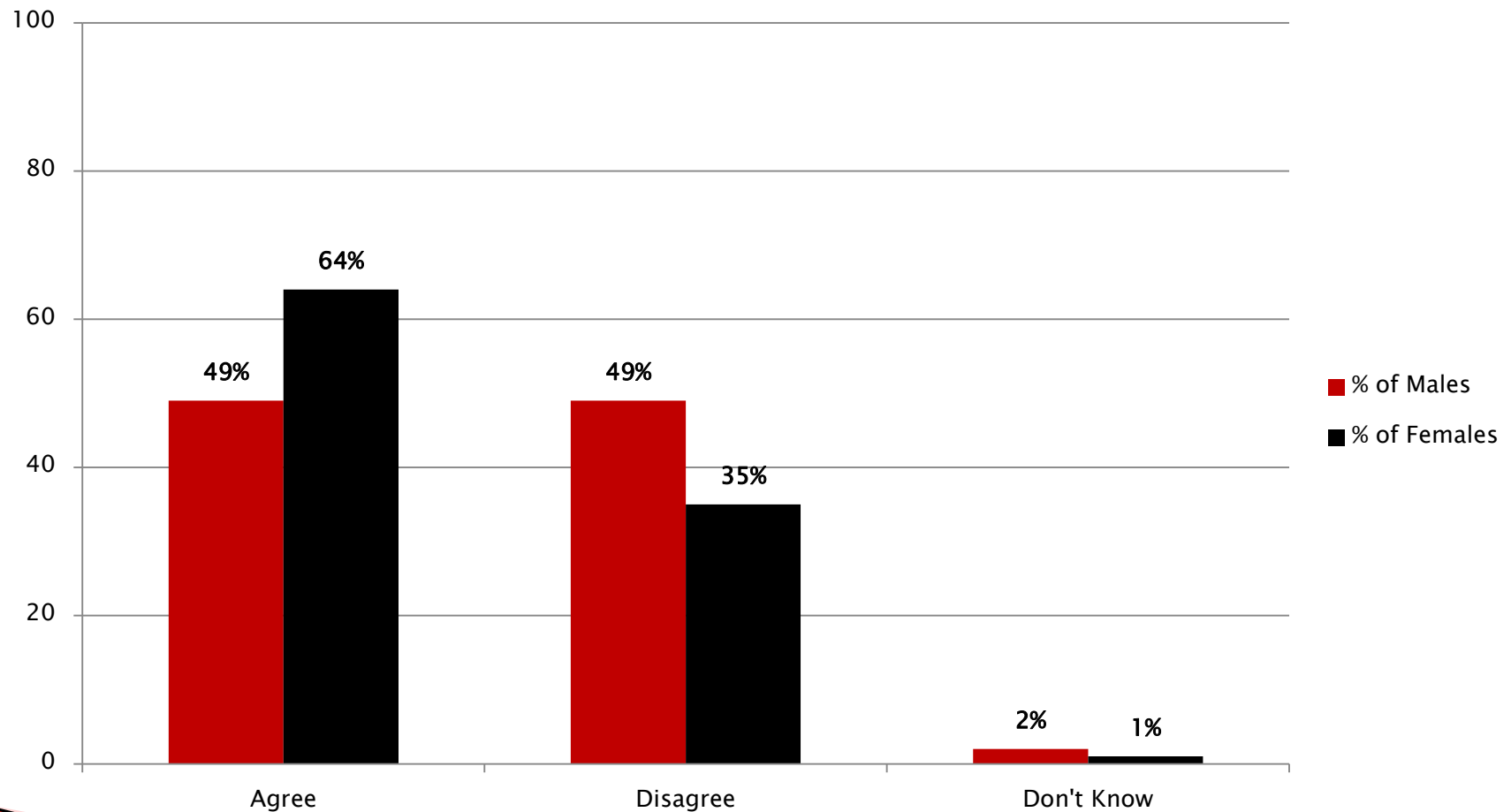

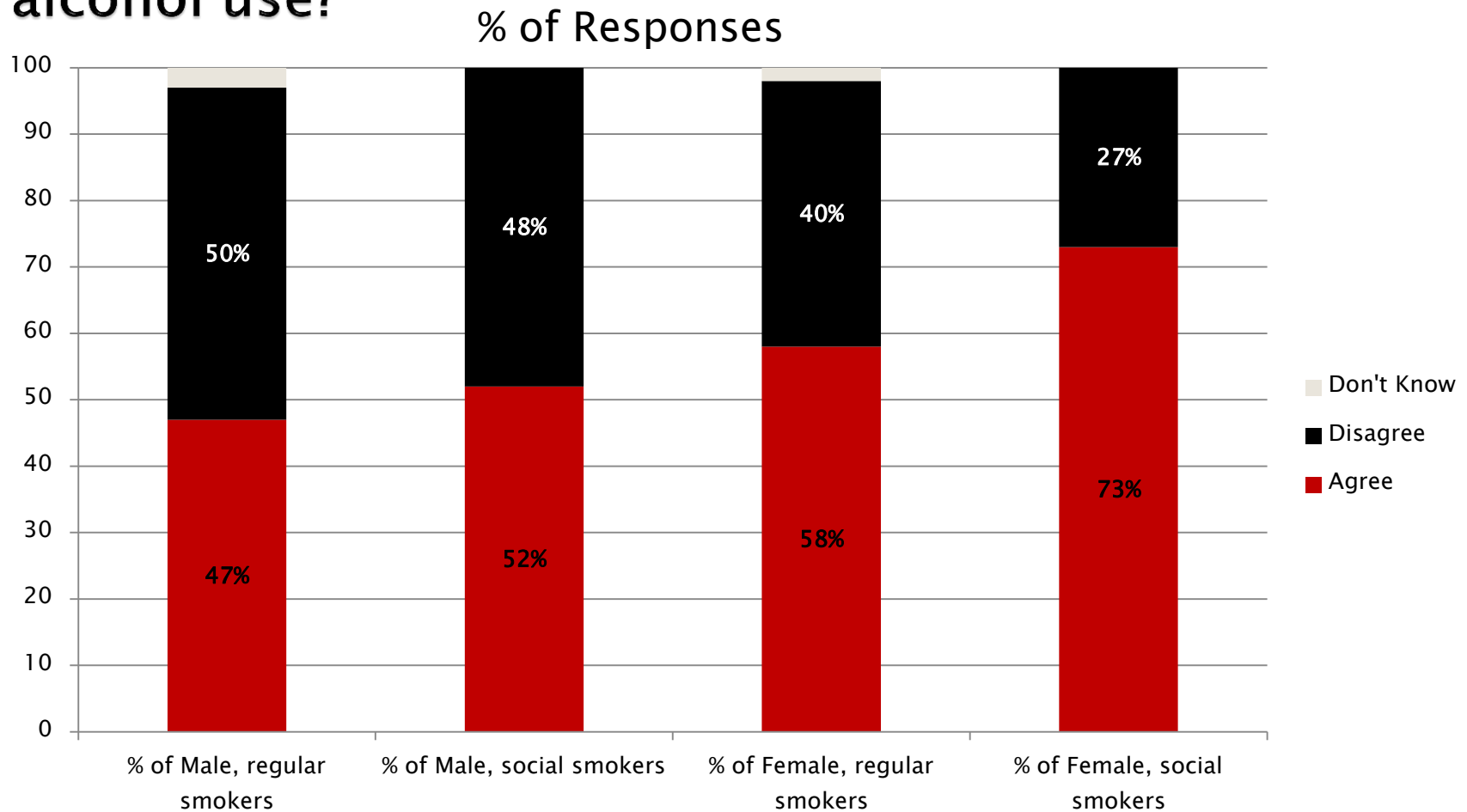
“Would you strongly agree, agree, disagree or strongly disagree with the following statement: there is a connection between my tobacco use and my alcohol use?”



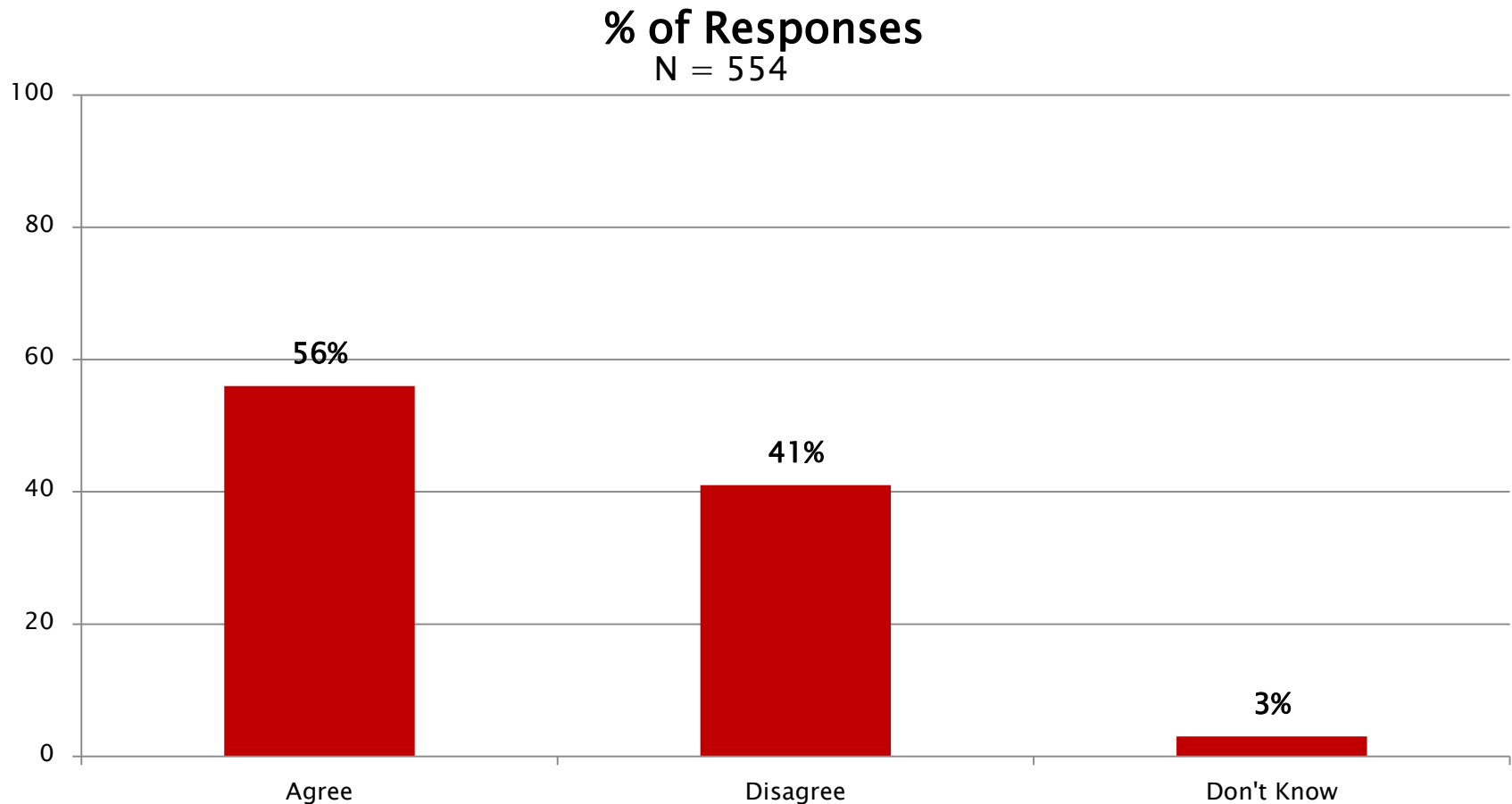

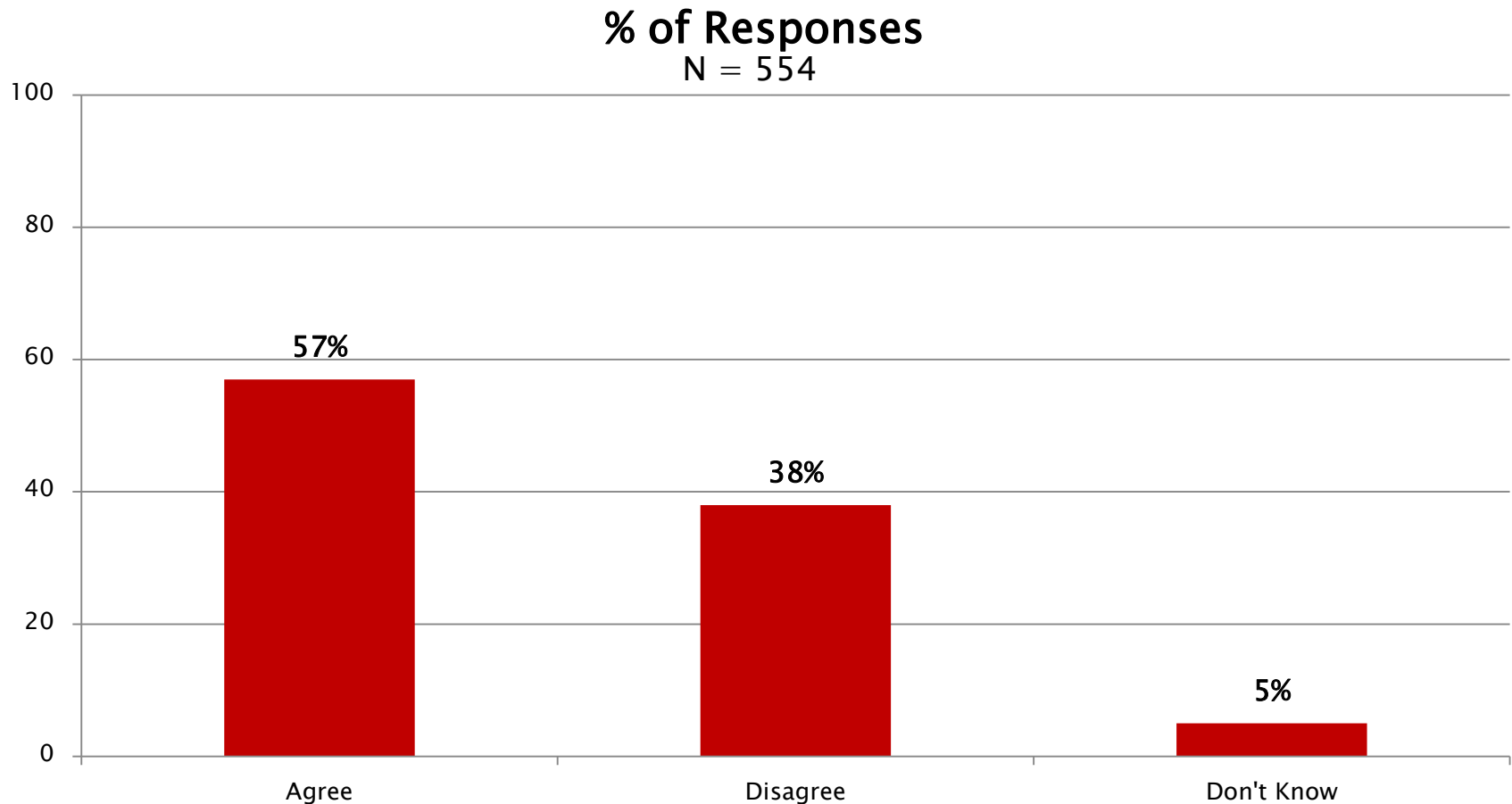

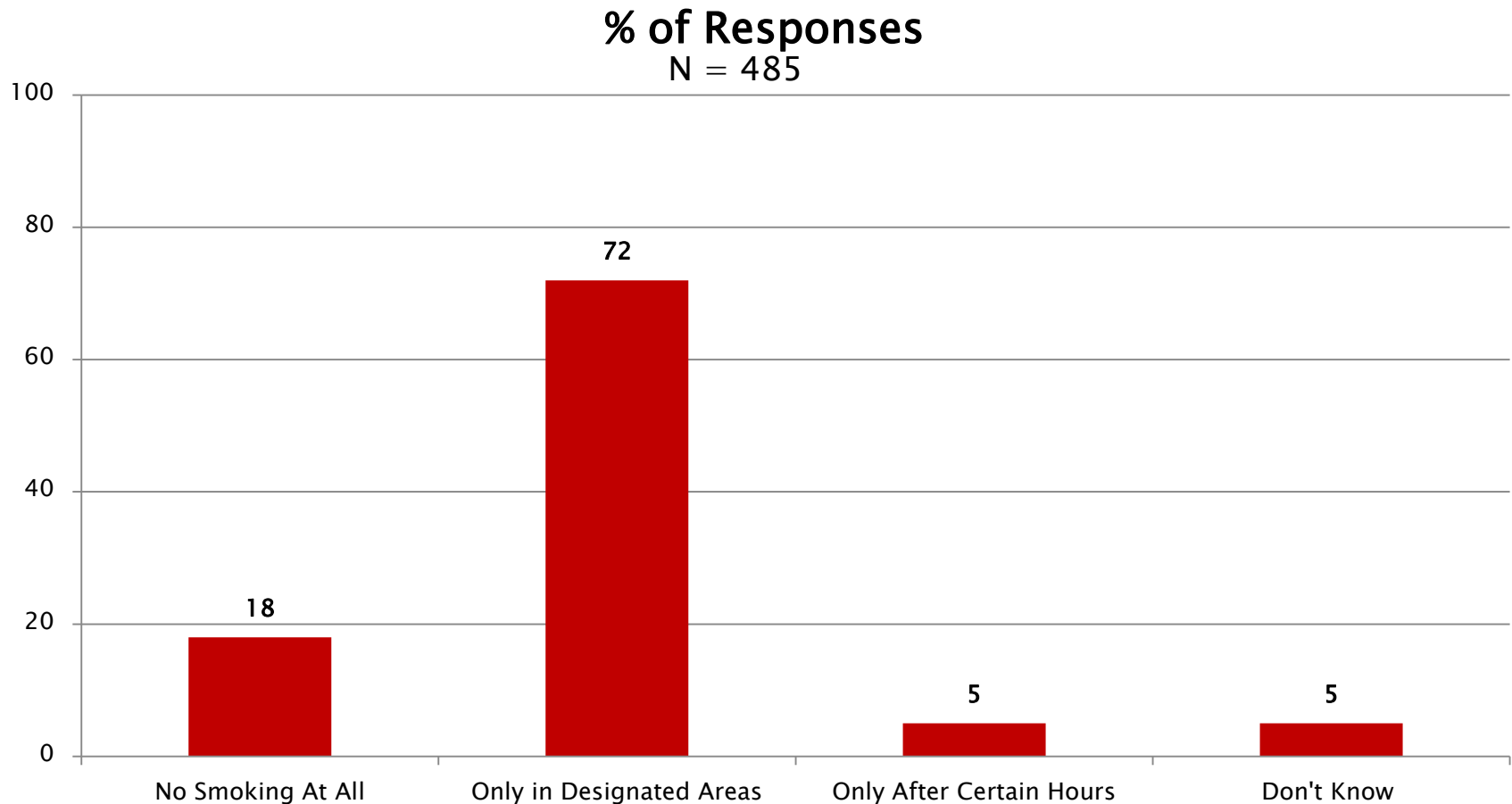
“Would you strongly agree, agree, disagree or strongly disagree with the following statement: I am bothered by other people smoking around me?”

“What do you think the restrictions of the smoking ban should be” (asked only to those who agreed with the smoking ban)

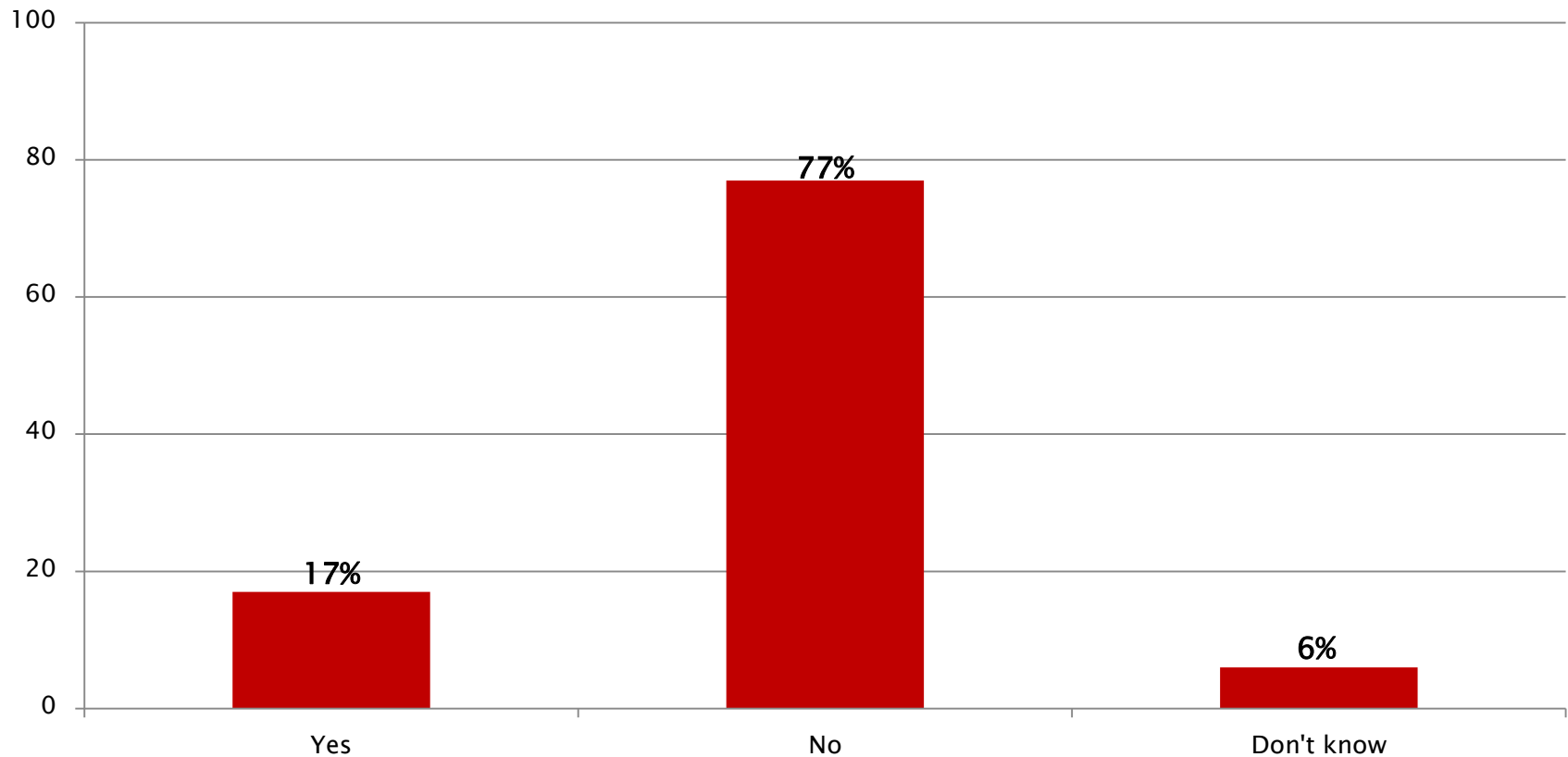

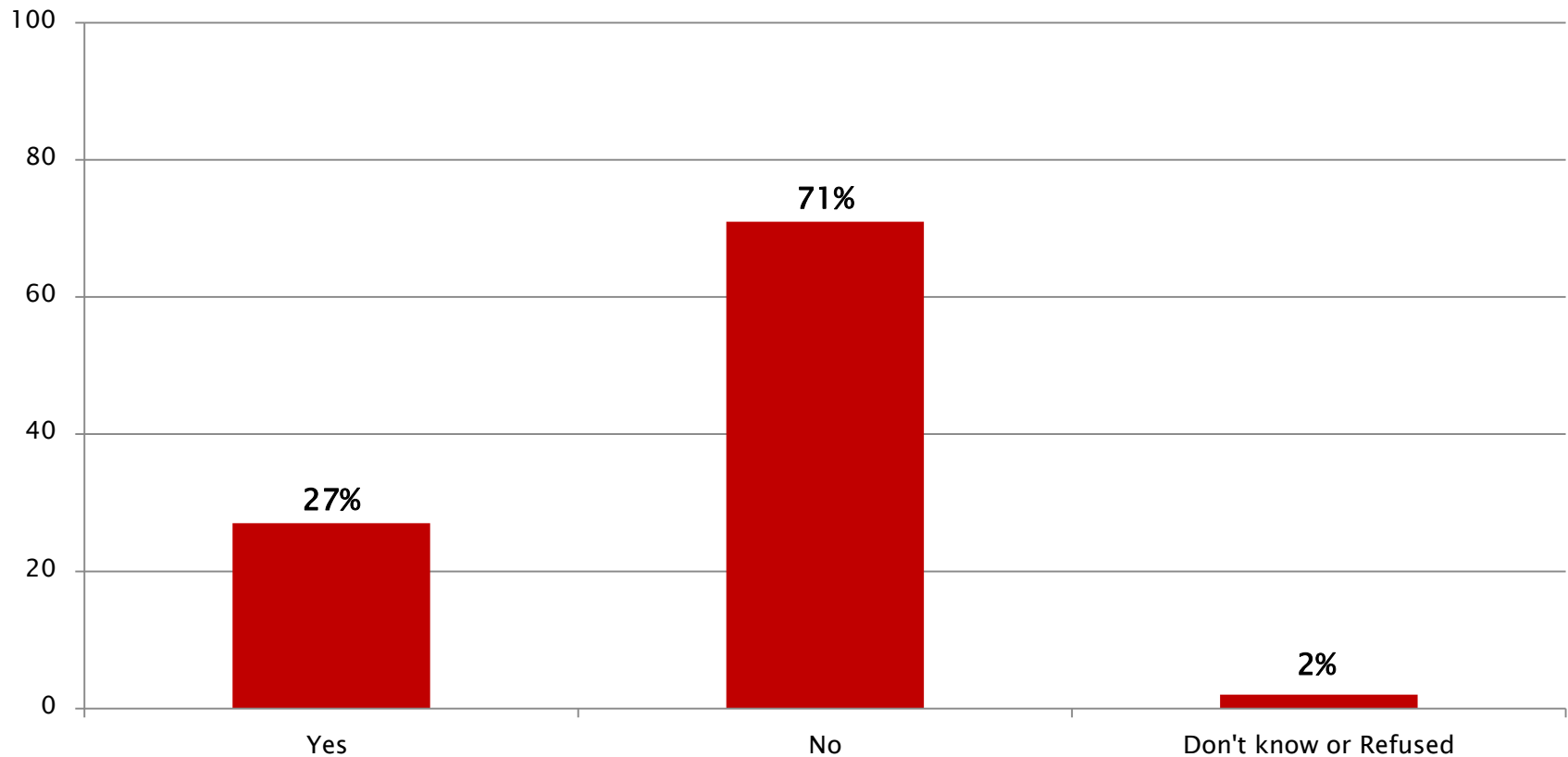
“In your opinion, do you think SCSU’s Dry Campus policy prevents students from drinking alcohol on campus?”
