



# Sample Error


- ▶ **546** respondents completed the survey.
  - ▶ The margin of sampling error for the complete set of weighted data is  $\pm 4$  percent at the 95 percent confidence level.
  - ▶ Then analysis is made of sub-samples such as respondent gender, dorm residence, etc., the sample error may be larger.

# Have you in any way changed your social drinking tendencies?




Gamma = .26, statistically significant at .05

# How satisfied were you with your experience on campus?





# Would you rather make cuts in the university budget or raise the cost of tuition to make up for the budget deficit?




Do you feel the job that SCSU does as a whole in the area of advising is very good, good, poor, or very poor?

Do you feel the job that SCSU as a whole in the area of advising is very good, good, fair, or poor?




