Transfer Guide

Bachelor of Science – Communication Sciences and Disorders

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders should follow the admission procedures located on the following website in order to be admitted to St. Cloud State University: www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer.

The following courses transfer from Normandale CC to SCSU and will fulfill ASHA Standards

Normandale Community College Course		SCSU Course
PSYC 2210 – Lifespan Development	→	PSY 240 <u>or</u> CEEP 262 <i>*Required for major and an option for ASHA Social/Behavioral Sciences Standard</i>
BIOL 1102 – Human Biology	→	BIOL 103 – Human Biology <i>*option for ASHA Biological Sciences Standard</i>
PHYS 1110 – Principles of Physics I <u>OR</u> CHEM 1061 – Principles of Chemistry 1	→	PHYS 231 <u>OR</u> CHEM 210 <i>*option for ASHA Physical Sciences Standard</i>
MATH 1090 – Statway Statistics 2 <u>OR</u> MATH 1080 – Intro to Stats	→	STAT 193 <i>*ASHA Statistics Standard</i>

Note: Either Chemistry or Physics is preferred to meet ASHA Physical Sciences standard, but not required. ASHA will also consider Astronomy or Earth and Atmospheric Science as a “Physical Science”.

Notes:

- *Note:* To meet ASHA (American Speech-Language-Hearing Association) Certification Standards, students must take one course in each of these four areas: Biological Sciences, Physical Sciences, Social/Behavioral Sciences, and Statistics. Suggestions are provided in the table above.
- The Communication Sciences and Disorders B.S. degree requires electives or the completion of a minor in another department.
- It is recommended that students take the lower-division major courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or Associate in Arts (AA) degree if possible.
- If a student completes a goal area within the MnTC, the same goal area will be completed at St. Cloud State University once transferred.
- Completion of 10 goal areas (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at St. Cloud State University) is required to earn a degree from SCSU.
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) are required to graduate from SCSU
