Pre-Nursing Transfer Guide

Transfer Process

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing should follow the admission procedures located on the following website in order to be admitted to St. Cloud State University:

Requirements for Admission to the Nursing Major

- Completion of 30 credits or more of preadmission courses: ENGL191, CMST 192, MATH/STAT 193, PHIL 194, PHIL 212, PSY 240, SOC 160, CHEM 141, BIOL 202, BIOL 204, and BIOL 206.
- Students are required to successfully complete all prerequisite courses with a grade of “C” or better and have an overall preadmission GPA of 2.75 or higher (the average GPA of those admitted into the program is about a 3.48).
- A formal application is required for admission to the major; admission to the nursing major is highly competitive. PSY 240, BIOL 202, and CHEM 141 must be completed in order to make application into the program.
- The deadline for completed applications is September for admission beginning the following spring semester and January for admission beginning the following fall semester. Please see www.stcloudstate.edu/nursing for upcoming deadlines.

SOCI 1710 – Introduction to Sociology	→	SOC 160 – Principles of Sociology
CHEM 1700 – Chemistry Concepts OR CHEM 1711 – Chemistry I OR CHEM 1712 – Chemistry II	→	CHEM 160 (<i>not required for Nursing program, but will fulfill prerequisite for CHEM 141 at SCSU</i>)
BIOL 2721 – Human Anat/Physiology I	→	BIOL 202 - Human Anatomy and Physiology I
BIOL 2722 - Human Anat/Physiology II	→	BIOL 204 - Human Anatomy and Physiology II
BIOL 2750 – General Microbiology	→	BIOL 206 - Microbiology

Notes:

- The GPA of any preadmission course(s) transferred to SCSU will count in the admission process.

- It is recommended that students take the above courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or Associate in Arts (AA) degree. If a student completes a goal area within the MnTC, the same goal will be completed at St. Cloud State University once transferred.
- Admission to SCSU does not guarantee admission to the Nursing major.
- Completion of 10 goal areas (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at SCSU).
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) are required to graduate from SCSU.
- It is highly recommended that transfer students with the Nursing Student Services Coordinator prior to transferring to SCSU.
