### Bachelor of Science - Social Work Transfer Guide

#### **Transfer Process**

All transfer students seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Social Work should follow the admission procedures located on the following website in order to be admitted to St. Cloud State University: [www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer](http://www.stcloudstate.edu/transfer). Being admitted to SCSU is a separate process than that of being admitted into a major program. A student may apply to the social work major after all core courses have been completed.

#### **Requirements for Admission to the Social Work Major**

- Students are eligible to apply when they have completed the following **Social Work Core** courses: SW 195, SOC 160, CEEP 262 or PSY 240, BIOL 103, HURL 201, HURL 206, STAT 193
- Minimum GPA of 2.60
- Grade of “C-” or better in each core course and each major course
- Students apply for admission the semester they are enrolled in SW 340

#### **The following Social Work Core courses transfer from Century College to SCSU**

Century College Course		SCSU Course
PSYC 1040 – Lifespan Psychology <u>or</u> PSYC 1041 – Developmental Psychology	→	PSY 240 <u>or</u> CEEP 262
SOC 1020 – Intro to Sociology	→	SOC 160
BIOL 1030 – Basic Human Anat & Phys <u>or</u> BIOL 1032 – Human Anat & Phys II	→	BIOL 103
MATH 1025 – Stats	→	Substitute for STAT 193

#### **The following Social Work Core courses need to be taken at SCSU: SW 195, HURL 201, HURL 206**

- It is recommended that students take the Social Work Core courses as a part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) or Associate in Arts (AA) degree.
- If a student completes a goal within the MnTC, the same goal will be completed at SCSU once transferred.

#### **Additional Requirements to Consider when Degree Planning**

- Completion of 10 goals (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at SCSU)
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) required to graduate from SCSU
- Additional major requirements: SW 216, 330, 340, 345, 350, 360, 410, 411, 412, 443, 444, 445.
  - The major requirements are organized sequentially into 4 total semesters (2 years) and cannot be taken in conjunction with any core classes.
  - Typically the major courses are offered in the following format:
    - 1<sup>st</sup> semester: M/W, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> semester: T/Th, 4<sup>th</sup> semester: Fridays
