It is recommended that students take these courses as part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC).

If a student completes a Goal area within the MnTC, the same Goal area will be complete at SCSU once transferred.

### Additional Requirements to Consider when Degree Planning:

- Completion of 10 Goals (40 credits) in the MnTC (known as the Liberal Education Program at SCSU)
- 40 upper-division credits (300-400 level coursework) are required to graduate from SCSU
- Completion of three Diversity classes. (Maybe adjusted depending on the amount of transfer credits). One diversity
  course must be an approved Racial Issues Graduate Requirement (RIGR) course (see Goal 7 for RIGR courses)
- Complete Residency Requirement. 30 credits must be earned at SCSU
- Earn a minimum of 120 credits to graduate with a bachelor's degree
- Must maintain a major GPA of least 2.5 after being admitted
- Additional major course requirements to be taken at SCSU
