How to Access the Degree Audit Report:

- 1. Go to the Office of Records and Registration homepage at http://www.stcloudstate.edu/srfs
- 2. Click on the e-Services button on the top right side of the webpage. Enter your StarID and Password.



3. Click on "Academic Records" on the left side of the webpage. Then click on "Degree Audit."



4. Click on "Click on Request a Degree Audit." Enter your StarID and password.

Degree Audit is a self-directed, automated electronic tool for tracking your progress toward completing an academic program (degree, diploma, or certificate). It provides a personalized listing of required, completed, in-progress, and needed courses.
