 - O Have the right for free speech but not appropriate to put down others
 - o Feels like they want to offend people is there only goal
 - O How can we call this home if we don't feel safe and welcome to be here
 - When is this going to change before something bad happens
 - Show the unrest of the people and cannot tolerate this anymore
 - o Challenge us to make a change or they will
 - o Disappointed in the University for not representing it appropriately
 - Curiosity about the process of approval for this case and why hate speech was approved.
 - o Question of Student Government's role in posters and displays
 - Concern about student input not being taken into consideration when asked for during open forums
