

The mission of TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) is to provide eligible students with a range of services including support and encouragement, academic and financial guidance, mentoring, individual tutoring services, math and science instruction, reading and writing instruction, accessible tutoring rooms, and graduate school planning.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment at SCSU, be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, be pursuing your <u>first</u> <u>bachelor's degree</u>, and have at least **one** of the following federally defined criteria apply to you at time of application (one need to verify once):

- First generation college student (neither parent nor guardian has received a four year (BACHELOR'S) degree)
- Income eligible (based on taxable household income.)
- > A student with a documented disability (diagnosed by a medical doctor or verified by Student Accessibility Services (SAS)

<u>Although you may be eligible and may quailfy for Student Support Services.</u> Only applicants who provide copies or justification for missing paperworks will be approved for services.

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- Most recent Federal Income Tax Return (1040, 1040A, 1040 EZ)—<u>first two pages only</u>. If you identify as an **independent** student (i.e.
- 24 years of age or older, married, have legal dependents, homeless youth, foster care youth, or serve in the military) bring your most current return; however, if you identify as a **dependent** (i.e. you are claimed by your parent or guardian, bring your parent's most current return.)
- If you identify as a student with a disabilityand would like consideration under this qulaiifcation, please include referral letter from Disability Services with your application.
- Your most recent transcript (unofficial or official).

SELECTION PROCESS

When there is limited space in the TRIO SSS program, priority with be given to:

- > Students who are both first generation college students and income eligible (BASED ON TAXABLE INCOME not gross income).
- Students who are both students with disabilities and income eligible (BASED ON TAXABLE INCOME not gross income)
- Alumni of other TRIO programs or other pre-college programs: Upward Bound, Veteran Upward Bound, Talent Search, Educational Opportunity Center, McNair Scholars Program, other Student Support Services program, AVID or College Possible.
- Students who are motivated to take full advantage of services offered through TRIO SSS.
- Students planning to continue their enrollment in a graduate or professional program.

Early inquiries are encouraged as applications are accepted on a first come first served basis.
