## FALL 2023 PROGRESS REPORT CAMPAIGN RECAP

As of 10/18/23

**1,357** CASES WERE OPENED BASED ON THE  
FACULTY ALERTS.

**1,117** CASES HAVE BEEN CLOSED.

STAFF HAVE MADE CONTACT WITH STUDENTS  
IN **71%** OF CASES.

This Progress Report Campaign focused  
specifically on identifying students who were at  
major risk in their spring courses, including:

- Students who haven't attended, or who have only attended a 1 – 2 classes
- Students who haven't logged into homework platforms (D2L, TopHat, MyMathLab, etc.) or have only logged in 1 – 2 times
- Students who haven't submitted any homework or assignments
- Students with current grade D or F

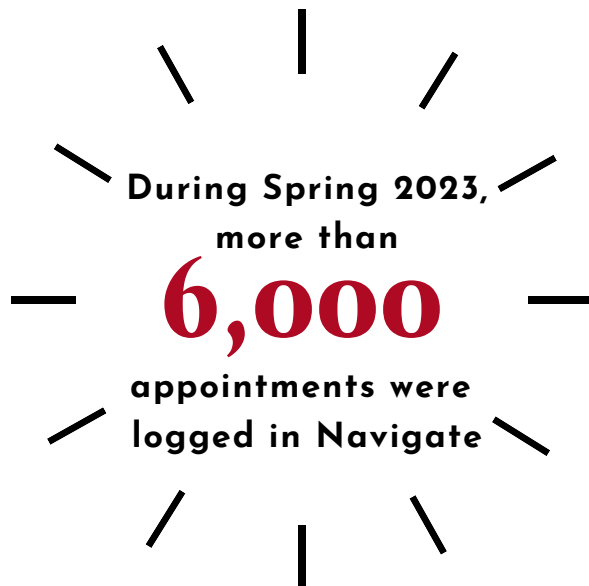

# Connections make a difference!



**In Spring 2023, we included 872 students in our Progress Report Campaign.**

**61.7% of the students who met with their advisor at some point during the spring persisted to Fall 2023, compared to a 58.5% persistence rate for those who did not meet with their advisor.**

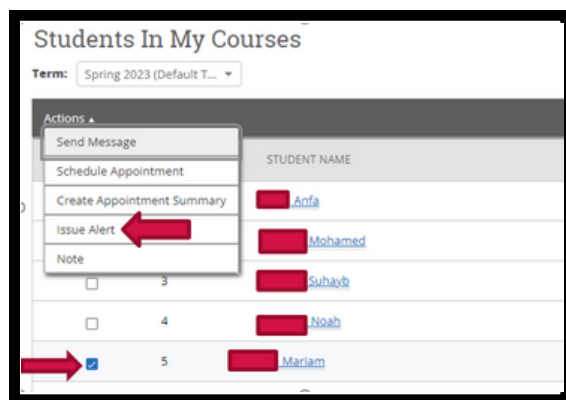

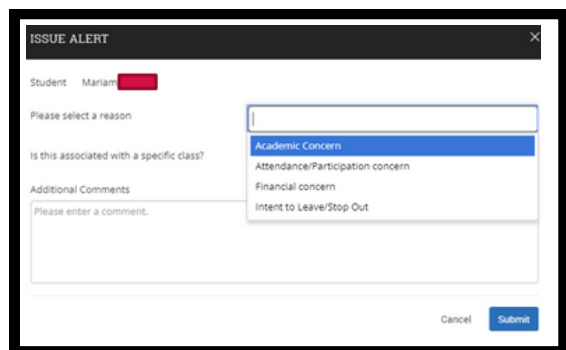
