SPRING 2023 PROGRESS REPORT CAMPAIGN RECAP

As of 4/3/23

1,376 CASES WERE OPENED BASED ON THE FACULTY ALERTS.

1,361 CASES HAVE BEEN CLOSED.
STAFF HAVE MADE CONTACT WITH STUDENTS IN
66% OF CASES.

This Progress Report Campaign focused specifically on identifying students who were at major risk in their spring courses, including:

- Students who haven't attended, or who have only attended a 1 – 2 classes
- Students who haven't logged into homework platforms (D2L, TopHat, MyMathLab, etc.) or have only logged in 1 – 2 times
- Students who haven't submitted any homework or assignments
- · Students with current grade D or F

SUCCESS MARKERS

Success Markers represent key academic milestones for students in a given program. They allow staff and faculty to monitor successful completion of important courses and intervene with students who are not meeting the recommended markers.

In 2021-22, SCSU launched the Success Markers pilot program using Guided Learning Pathways funding with four participants: Criminal Justice, Biomedical Science, Biology: Biodiversity, Ecology and Evolution, and Early Childhood Education. Since then, we have expanded Success Markers to Physics and STEM Education programs.

Success Markers provide a way to provide more targeted intervention to help keep students on track toward their degree, as well as offering students encouragement as they successfully complete the milestones indicated by the Success Markers. For example, in the Criminal Justice program students who successfully completed a Success Markers course would get a letter from the Dean congratulating them and encouraging them to continue their good work.

STUDENT SUCCESS COACH

We are rolling out the Student Success Coaches (SSC) for all students by the end of next year. So, students will be assigned an SSC based on their major and they can schedule an appointment through Navigate.

ENROLLMENT CAMPAIGN

Fall 2023 Registration Campaign 04/01/23 - 08/18/23

It is designed to help enroll more students on time. Students are encouraged to register on time to ensure:

- They get the classes they need to stay on track for graduation.
- They have more choice in the days/times and delivery mode of courses.

Students can schedule an appointment with their advisor to register for Fall classes. The advisors will help them make sure they're on track and connect with resources to be successful.

FACULTY CHAMPION

What features of Navigate do you use most frequently?

The Navigate feature I use the most is the campaign function to encourage psychology majors to meet with me or their advisors. Because we now have professional advisors who also help our students, I try to write notes about my meetings. That way I can remember what the student and I discussed and the professional advisors can see this information. I also like to use Navigate when students want to add psychology a minor for a brief description of the student (major, minor, number of credits).

How has Navigate made a difference in your work?

I think that Navigate has been a difference in reaching out to the students. Along with Microsoft Bookings, Navigate has reduced the number of emails to find a time to meet that works for both the student and myself.
