

2021-2022 Scholarships



More than \$38,000 in scholarships were awarded for Academic Year 2021-22. Recipients were notified in May, 2021. Scholarship applications for Academic year 2022-2023 will open January 1, 2022 and are due in March, 2022 via [Huskies Scholarships](#).

Personal essays that demonstrate commitment to education, financial need that align with scholarship criteria are critical to award decisions. Unless noted, scholarships have been specified by the donor for women students.

Claude F. and Helen I. DelZoppo Scholarship

\$600 (1 award)

This scholarship is available for eligible students who are at least 25 years old and are working to overcome significant personal obstacles in order to continue working toward completion of undergraduate degree. Preference is given to students from the Iron Range – including Duluth and Grand Rapids.

Elizabeth L. Howard Scholarship for Women

\$2,500 (6 awards)

This scholarship is available for eligible students who are at least 25 years old and have a personal career goal requiring a college degree in order to help others directly, through teaching, a career in medicine, or a similar field.

Grace McDowall Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000 (3 awards)

This scholarship is available for eligible students who are at least 35 years old and have evidence of community service; volunteerism or political action and work on social concerns in the past and in future plans. Undergraduate female students receive priority consideration for this scholarship, but graduate students are eligible to apply and have received awards in the past.

Marcia Summers Career Opportunity Scholarship for Single Mothers

\$1,000 (1 award)

The purpose of this scholarship is to financially assist St. Cloud State University students who are single mothers of minor children (the applicants may be never-married, widowed or divorced with custody). Available for eligible students who have demonstrated the ability to achieve academically. Must have attained 30 credits or more.

Mary Jane Young Scholarship

\$2,000 (6 awards)

Mary Jane believed in empowering women through education and was committed to providing opportunities for re-entry women to pursue their educational goals. This scholarship is available for eligible students who are at least 25 years of age, a U.S. citizen, and reentering college after delaying their education.

Elaine Leach Women in Educational Administration Endowed Scholarship

\$1,500 (2 awards)

Elaine L. Leach, retired professor at SCSU, taught in the field of educational leadership and administration with a long, distinguished career in educational administration. She established this scholarship to support women in this field who need financial assistance for their educational pursuits and career development. Available for students admitted and enrolled into the graduate program of Educational Administration and Leadership, plan to establish or continue their careers as educational leaders in rural MN districts, at least three years experience as classroom teachers, have well developed plans for their academic goals toward leadership in rural MN. Part time students are eligible.

Mary B. Craik Endowed Fund

\$1,500-2,500 (1 award)

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships and/or funding to support projects initiated by women to foster global social and environmental justice. This scholarship is available for eligible students who demonstrate a strong commitment to social and environmental justice or engage in projects fostering global social and environmental justice. Preference is given to women of color or women with disabilities when all other factors are equal.

Women's Fund Scholarship for Women in Transition

\$1,000 (1 award)

The Women's Fund of the Central Minnesota Community Foundation is supporting scholarships for women in transition, including first generation college students, immigrants and/or non-traditional students. This scholarship is available to undergraduate women students who are in life transition (examples include but are not limited to: immigration, divorce, abuse, addiction recovery, and early pregnancy), are residents of central Minnesota, and show evidence of financial need.

SCSU Faculty Wives and Women Scholarship for Non-traditional Students

\$1000 (1 award)

Female student age 25 or older with family responsibilities, sophomore or junior during term scholarship is disbursed, 3.0 GPA, financial need.

Reclaiming Life (Recreandae Vitae Causa) Endowment

Scholarship is for a male undergraduate student who has initiated personal recovery from childhood sexual abuse/assault.
